



## ANNEX III: PARTICIPATING UN ORGANIZATIONS STRATEGY FOR THE 2020 CALL FOR PROPOSALS

#### I. Overall approach to UNRSF 2020 Call for Proposals

There is great concern over the slow progress in implementing the Decade of Action for Road Safety in Latin America and the Caribbean countries. Among the main challenges for this new decade are the need of update road safety policies and encourage enforcement actions under a comprehensive focus for reducing exposure to risk. On account of these challenges, this regional commission focus its actions in the area of road safety, especially in the creation of technical capacities to design, to monitor and to evaluate mid- and long-term road safety policies and strategies.

Consequently, ECLAC road safety actions seek to identify the missing or weak element(s) in the design and enforcement of polices and actions, the setting and monitoring of local, national or sub regional reduction targets as well as strengthening of national capacities for the detection and dissemination of good practices and technologies towards to the achievement of a comprehensive, sustainable and safe mobility system in the Latin America and the Caribbean countries.

#### II. Application strategy

This Regional Commission seeks a maximum of three projects linked with their programme of work, focused mainly in actions of research, technical assistance, identifying good practices, pilot projects with achievable results in short-term, creation of capacities, promotion of political dialogue and technical assistance for the improvement of road safety policies and actions.

Applications will be accepted by low- and middle-income UNECLAC member States, in line with United Nations rules and regulations. UNECLAC member States may also choose to submit collaborative proposals, with the support of external stakeholders, including NGOs, if they so wish.

**Completed “Application Form – Stage 1”** should be submitted via email to UNECLAC by 15 December 2020. Shortlisted proposals will be further elaborated during the month of January 2021, until the final selection of the three proposals submitted through/by the UNECLAC PUNO to the Fund, in line with the UNRSF Call for Proposals specifications.
