I. Overall approach to UNRSF 2020 Call for Proposals

The World Health Organization (WHO) supports Member States in establishing and implementing science-based policies supportive of road safety improvements as well as facilitating their adaptation to local contexts. Acting as a coordinator on road safety issues with the UN, WHO works in close collaboration with the UN and other road safety experts to gather information and build capacity in support of road safety improvements.

As part of its mandate, WHO inter alia provides guidance on evidence-based strategies, implements capacity building programmes and develops practical tools like assessment tools and tool kits to improve road safety. WHO's response to this funding call may address the following issues in any region of the world:

- Strengthening of data systems and reporting of road traffic deaths;
- Strengthening of road safety legislation and enforcement;
- Developing implementation strategies to guide the use of a systems approach to road safety in diverse contexts; and
- Enhancing the post-crash response.

II. Application strategy

WHO will consider submitting proposals in collaboration with Member States and non-state actors such as NGOs and academia. Interested organizations should send a brief description of the idea outlining the roles envisaged for each partner by 30 November 2020.
