CALP and ESD: 2010-2020

- CALP is a flagship initiative of CAREC undertaken since 2010 and designed to improve leadership capacity of young and mid-level managers of various environmental agencies of the region.
- It involves governments, academic, private sectors and NGO representatives an approach that helps to ensure a comprehensive understanding of environmental and SD issues from a regional perspective.
- CALP is designed to equip young leaders with cutting-edge knowledge and innovative leadership methodologies in responding to global, regional, and national environmental challenges.
- *CALP covers various SD themes:* water, climate change, energy, wastes, consumption & production, green economy, etc.
- CALP promotes *participation of young leaders in environmental decision-making* by using their leadership skills and increasing their knowledge.
- CALP promotes *ESD approaches, methodologies and values famous ESD speakers*
- **Special session in 2020 devoted to ESD:** the role of ESD and digitalization of education in response to global challenges
- CALP *promotes role of young leaders in transformations* in the field of the environment and sustainable development and in promoting the regional dialogue.








CALP in figures: 2010-2020


- √ 330 graduates from Central Asian countries and Afghanistan in 2021




11th CALP in 2020: response to the global challenges

- CALP covers six countries Central Asian plus Afghanistan
- In 2020, in the light of the global pandemic COVID-2019, there is an immediate need for an urgent recovery of economies, the environment, and adaptation to the new challenges in relation to the health and education systems.
- In 2020, despite the challenges the COVID-19 pandemic brought, CAREC with partners organised the 11th CALP and collected on the ZOOM platform 46 young leaders from Central Asia and Afghanistan, and about 70 exceptional speakers from all around the world.
- The 11th CALP demonstrated to the participants not only the problems posed by the pandemic, but discussed the window of opportunities.
- Members of the CALP alumni network participated as volunteers during the COVID-2019 pandemic in 2020 and motivated others.
