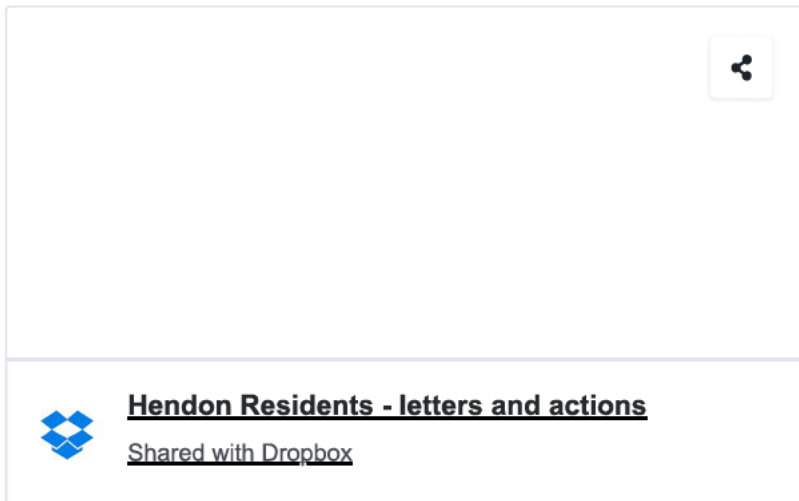

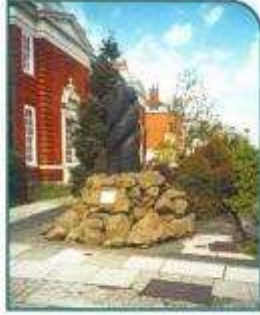
You will be receiving further communication from residents and local businesses shortly.
