There is indeed very little detail on the proposals which begs the question why are the council limiting the information being released when it is quite clear that there is more being held back. Nonetheless, I still think there is value in meeting to discuss the scheme at large and the impact that it will have on the local area. Obviously I cannot force you to meet with me but you are an elected official representing the interests of local residents - I will leave the ball in your court as to whether you feel there is value in scheduling some time.

You state that I should communicate my concerns with the University - are they the party who will be submitting planning? As I understand it the sites in question are council owned - if i'm correct i'm keen to understand the interplay between the two parties because logically it would seem that I should be communicating my concerns to the Council.

With regards to the building heights, it is stated that the buildings on Fenella & Ravensfield will be 7 storeys which is 5 higher than currently. To me this seems a little excessive and the new developments will undeniably overlook properties on Egerton Gardens.
