# Registers

- All data contained in the above mentioned documents are collected in the Central Register of Drivers and Vehicles (CEPiK).
- The records can be accessed online by all inspection services, including during roadside checks.

# Why you may not carry these documents

- Until now, according to the legislation, a citizen could be fined for the lack of any document,
- The police officer checked the data in the system, obtaining information on all necessary data
- It has therefore been decided to waive the obligation to carry these documents

# Offences, withdrawal, suspension, renewal and cancellation of driving licence

- In addition to accessing the driver's and vehicle's data in CEPiK, a police officer during a control may also:
  - Check the status of driving licence (valid, suspended, withdrawn, cancelled) registration certificate, roadworthiness test or insurance
  - Retain the driving licence or registration card electronically in the system (does not take away the physical document)

# Offences, withdrawal, suspension, renewal and cancellation of driving licence

- When a document is electronically retained, a receipt is issued and the information is forwarded to the authority that issued the document (driving licence or vehicle registration certificate).
- Further actions are carried out by the authority which issued the document - for example, it issues a formal decision on the retention of the driving licence.

# Documents can stay at home but what if there is a collision?

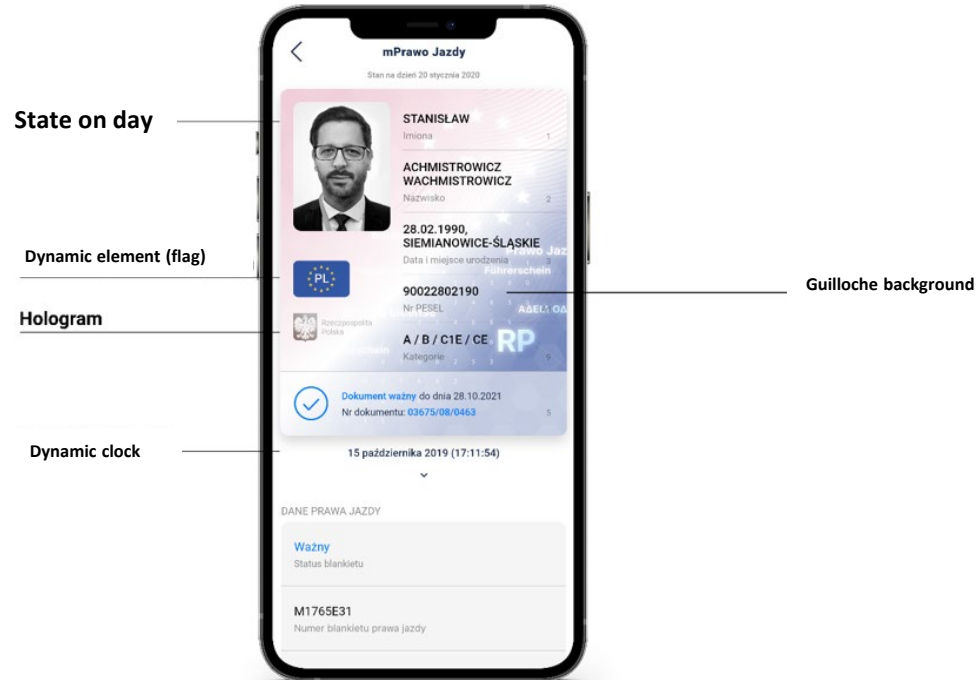
- It is not always necessary to call the police but there is a need to exchange data.



# What if there is a collision ?

- The application "mCitizen" was prepared
- The application includes electronic representation of documents issued in traditional form:
  - Identity card,
  - Driving licence,
  - Registration certificate,
  - Insurance policy

# What if there is a collision ?

- Citizens can use copies of the documents contained in this application to exchange data among themselves and as an auxiliary means of presenting them to the control authorities (e.g., in case of lack of access to the system on the road).

# What if there is a collision ?

- A QR code is used to confirm the originality of the submitted data and its exchange between individuals.

# Who can drive without a document in Poland.

- The introduced regulations apply only to persons holding documents issued in Poland.
