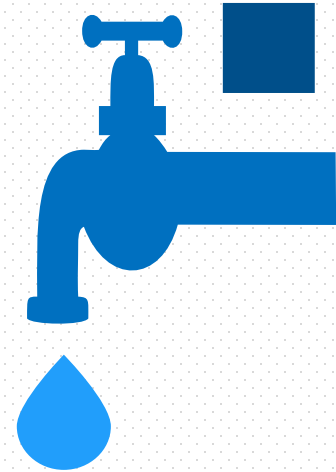

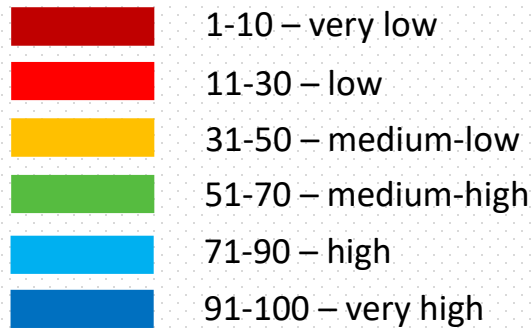

Degree of implementation of integrated water resources management (0-100)

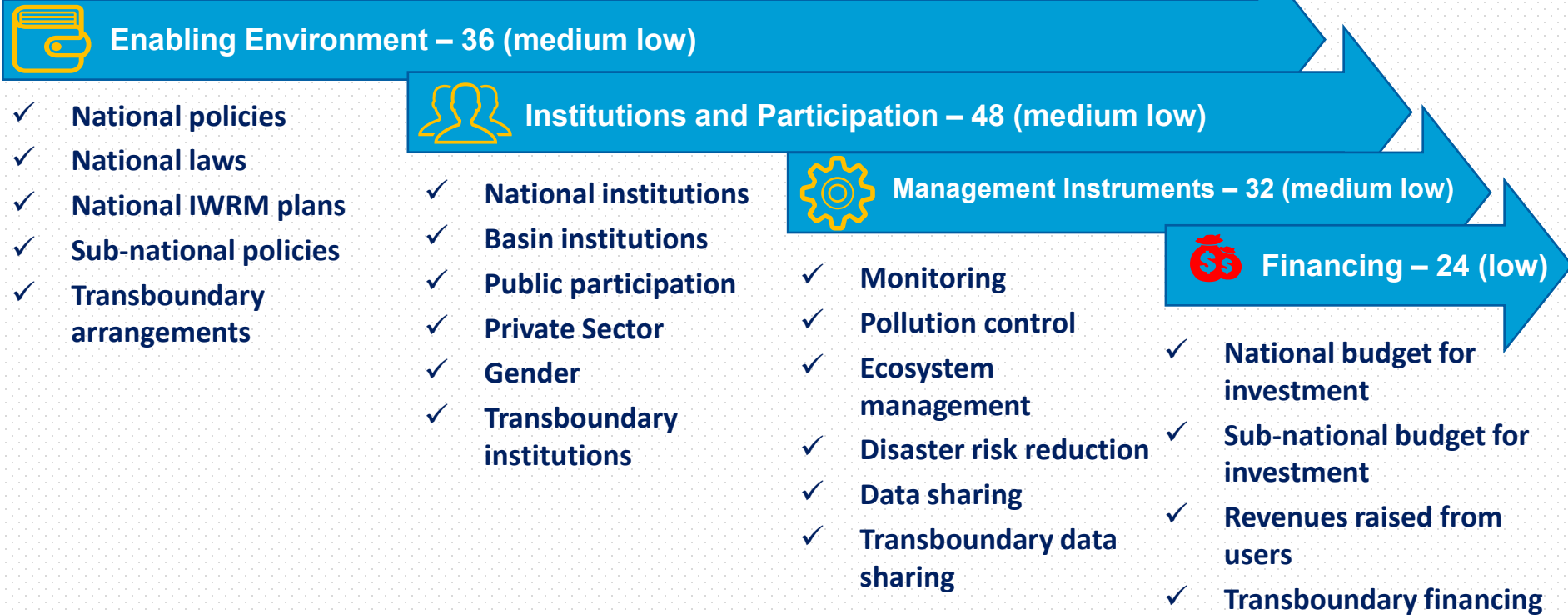

Proportion of transboundary basin area with an operational arrangement for water cooperation

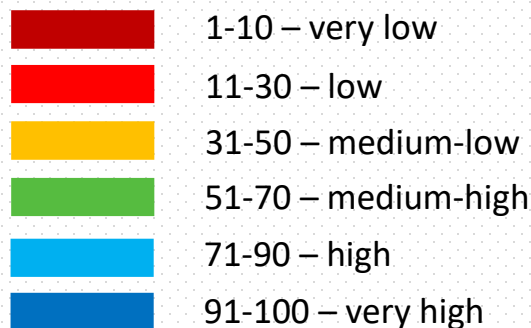

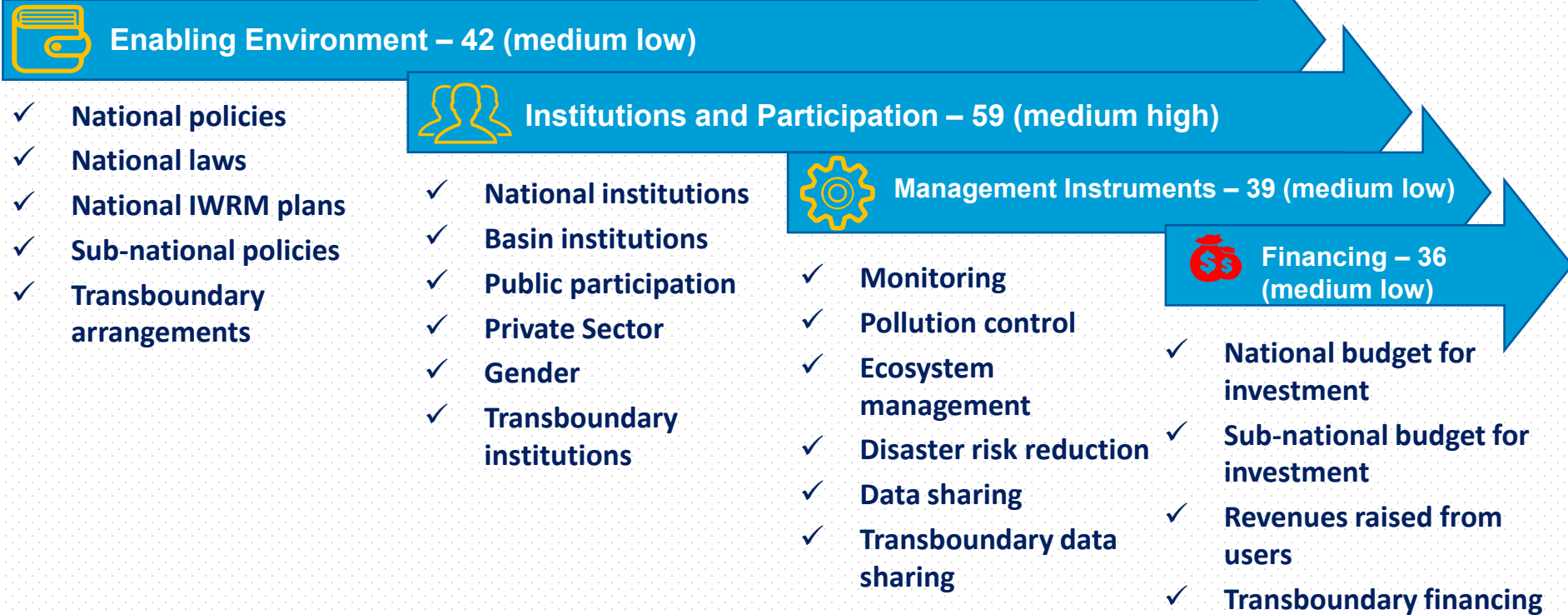

6.5.2 – Transboundary Cooperation

An “arrangement for water cooperation”

Joint body, joint mechanism or commission

Formal communications between riparian countries in form of meetings

Joint objectives, a common strategy, a joint or coordinated management plan, or an action plan

There is a regular exchange of data and information

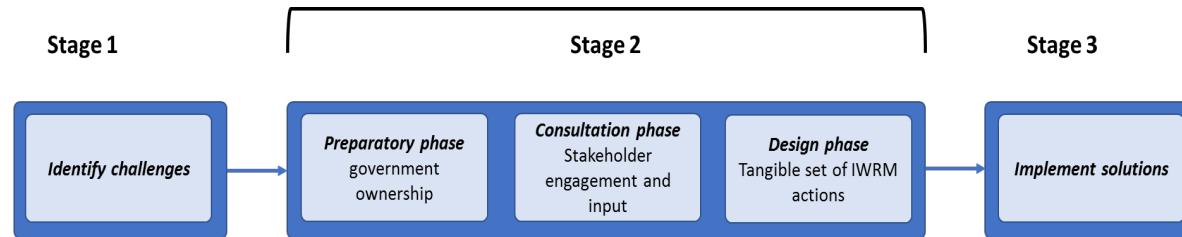

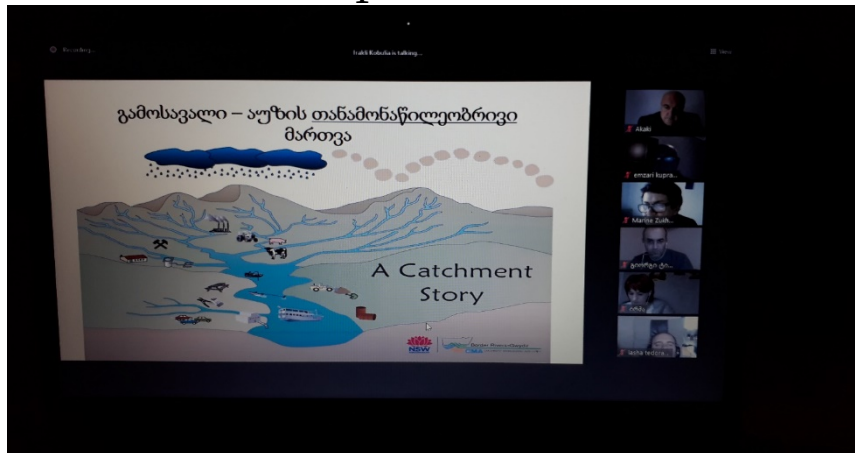

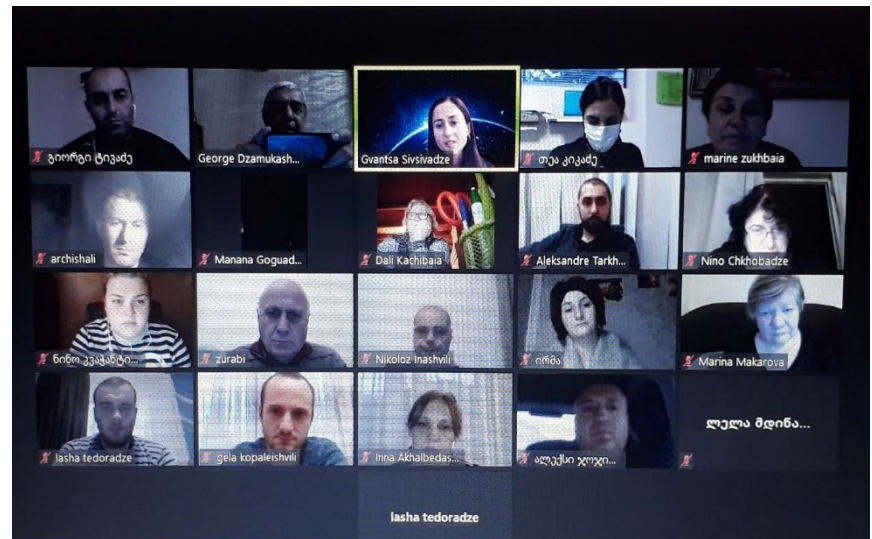
