Programme of Work for 2019-2021 Progress in implementing

Development of cooperation on transboundary river Syrdaria

- support to the Joint KZ-UZ Working Group on water quality of Syrdaria river
- development of the joint actions on prevention of accidental pollution of Syrdaria river
- implementation to be launched in July 2021

Capacity building on Hydro-meteorological Services

- Memorandum of understanding between KZ and SK MoEP on support to IWAC
- Training on hydro-meteorological services
- implementation September October 2021



Main areas of work for 2022-2024

- Supporting monitoring, assessment and information sharing in transboundary basins
- Promoting an integrated and cross-sectoral approach to water resources management at all levels
- Reporting on SDG 6.5.2 and implementation of the Convention



Supporting monitoring, assessment and information sharing in transboundary basins

Objective: to assist countries in developing coordinated monitoring and assessment, as well as data exchange in transboundary basins

<u>Planned activities:</u>

- Support on updating the Convention's guidelines on monitoring and assessment:
- Assistance in the development of joint actions to prevent water pollution in transboundary basins



Promoting an integrated and intersectoral approach to water resources management at all levels

Objective: to assist Eurasian countries in implementing integrated water resources management in transboundary basins

Planned activities

- Promote intersectoral solutions based on the water, food, energy and ecosystems nexus
- Promote integrated water resources management in the transboundary basins
- Assistance in the safe management of hydraulic structures



Reporting on Sustainable Development Goal indicator 6.5.2 and under the Convention

Objective: to assist countries to facilitate the achievement of SDG 6.5.2.

Planned activities

Facilitating the use of reports to improve transboundary water cooperation:

- support to countries in the preparation of the third reporting
- regional meeting on the exchange of experience in the use of reports as a tool for the development of cross-border cooperation
