- To develop recommendations for further improvement of national legislative and institutional frameworks on SEA in the country.















The SEA process assisted with the identification of major environmental and public health concerns in Orhei.

This allowed to formulate (in discussion with planners) number of measures to prevent, reduce or mitigate identified potential negative consequences for the environment and public health, which should be of priority in the context of the Master Plan implementation.




Comparison of the Master Plan Orhei 2015 and Master Plan of 2008;

Lesson Learned

A Program in the field of "green" economy is a very complex and complicated document (considering the complexity of the information included in the priority subfields (agriculture, regional development and green cities, energy, SMEs, transport), which makes SEA process involvement of planning experts in all areas of the national economy

The SEA process benefits from being accompanied by a well-structured and funded information and awareness campaign, focused on the most important target groups, vulnerable categories, gender, etc.

✓ SEA Guideline Development

The SEA Guidelines aims to support implementation of the draft Law on SEA by providing practical recommendations on how to apply the SEA procedure set out in the legislation. The working group for developing the SEA Guidelines was established having as representatives then Ministry of Environment, national and international consultants.
