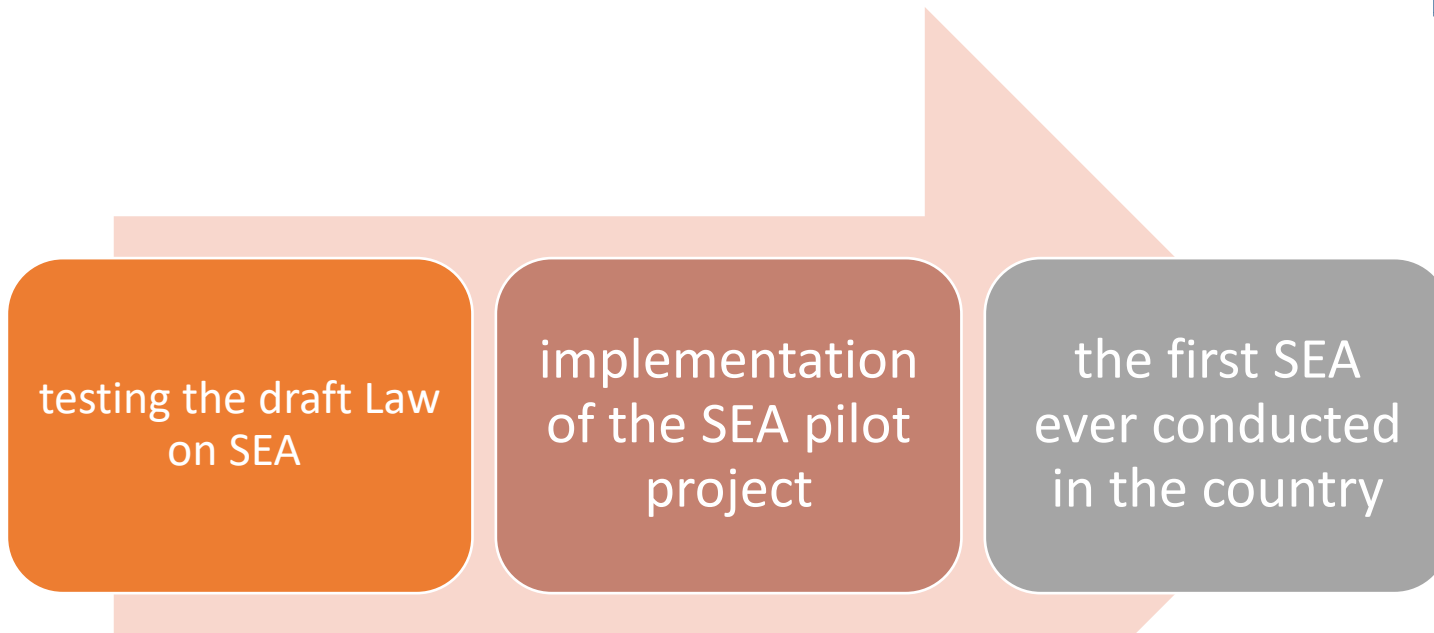

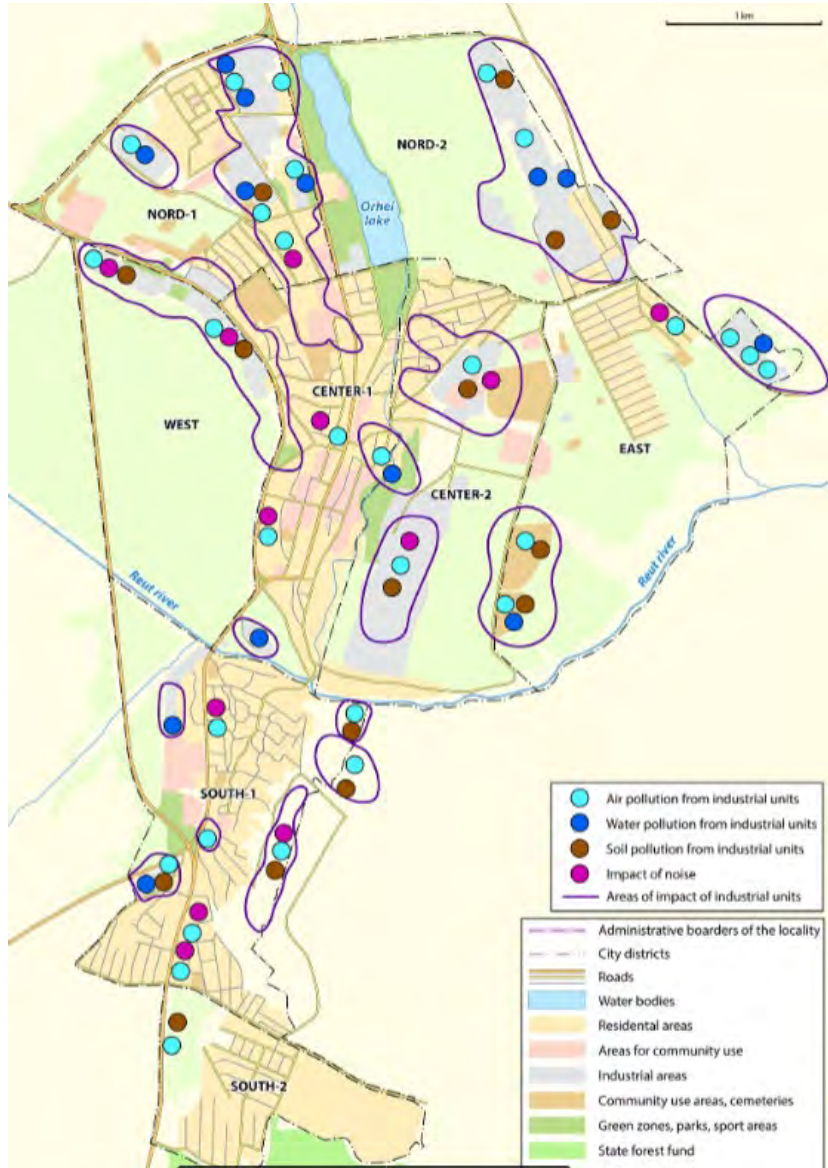
***The Orhei Town Master Plan was selected as the strategic document for the pilot SEA***

The objectives of the SEA pilot were defined as follows:

- To assess test and demonstrate opportunities of practical application of the draft law on SEA;
- To provide recommendations for environmental optimisation and modifications of the selected plan and programme;
- To develop recommendations for further improvement of national legislative and institutional frameworks on SEA in the country.

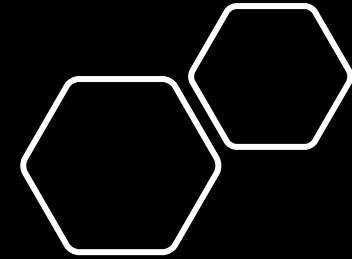

The SEA process assisted with the identification of major environmental and public health concerns in Orhei.

This allowed to formulate (in discussion with planners) number of measures to prevent, reduce or mitigate identified potential negative consequences for the environment and public health, which should be of priority in the context of the Master Plan implementation.

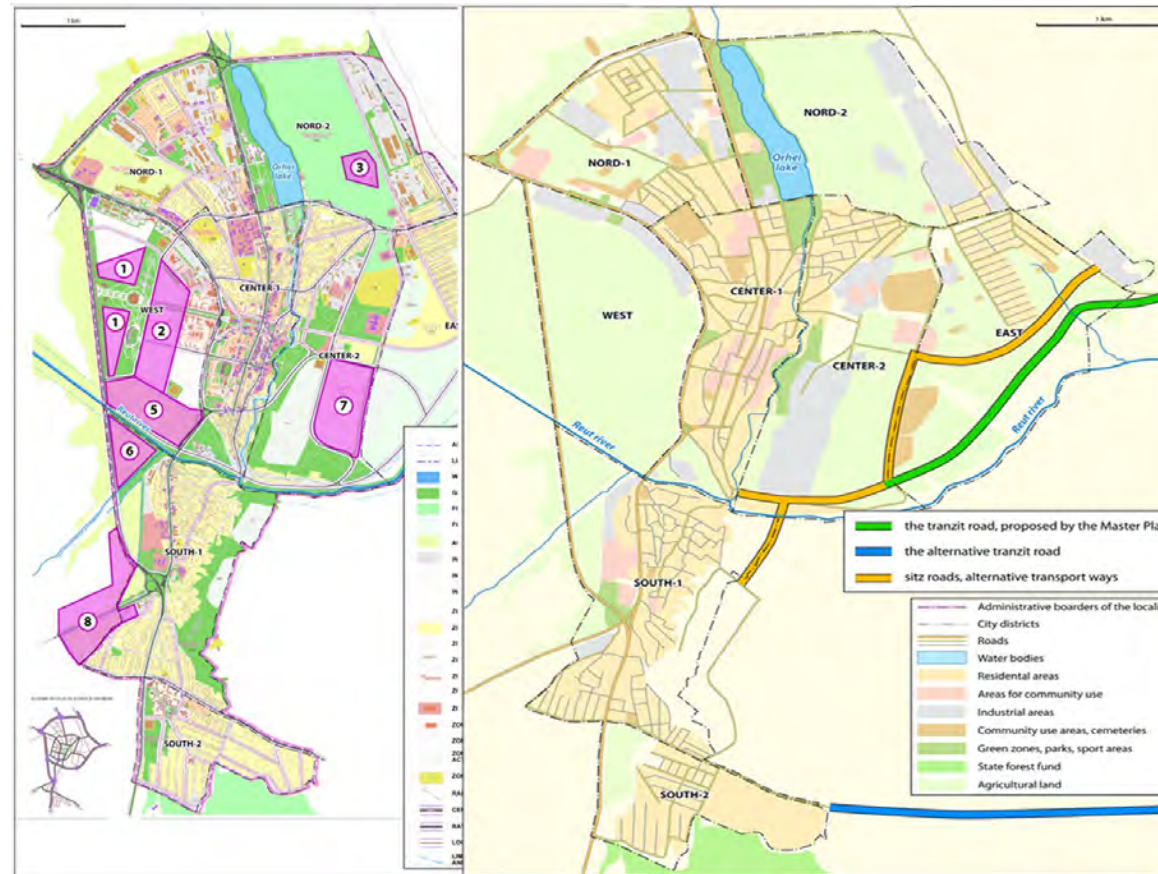
