Preparation to the Pilot Population Census

In compliance with the Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan no. 710 of November 11, 2020, and the Order of the State Committee on Statistics, new District (City) Census Departments were established

- 3** Full-time employees
- 1** Out of them, Head of Department
- 2** Specialists

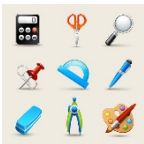

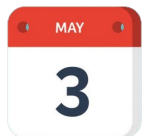
The staff of the State Committee on Statistics trained the enumerators
