

- ✓ Invitation for nomination sent to Ministers of Education via Permanent Delegation & National Commission
- ✓ 8 participants nominated per country
- ✓ Ministry of Education, other Ministries relevant to ESD, NGOs, youth delegates, academic sector, private sector
- ✓ UN Partners, international organizations, experts, NGOs, cities, youth invited by UNESCO



UNECE Member State Participation

- 46 UNECE Member states have submitted nominations for the Conference
- ✓ out of the total of 85 ministers and/or vice-ministers participating, some 30 are from UNECE Member states



Berlin Declaration

✓ Berlin Declaration as a short conference outcome document

✓ To reaffirm political commitment to ESD and the ESD for 2030 framework

- ✓ To promote ESD as a core component of education systems
- Member State delegates from the six UNESCO Regional Electoral Groups

- Zero draft: Prepared by UNESCO Secretariat
- First drafting group meeting: 4 March
- Consultation via Regional Offices to their government and civil society partner, UNESCO HQ to ESD stakeholders: 162 comments from 43 countries
- Second drafting group meeting: 6 April
- Consultation via National Commissions
- Third drafting group meeting: 4 May
- Adoption at the conference






Country initiatives on ESD for 2030

- Call for countries to implement country initiatives on ESD for 2030
 - Build on on-going efforts on ESD and possibly create new efforts
 - Engage multi-stakeholders from both education and sustainable development sectors
 - Country initiative template available
- UNESCO to provide technical support to organize preparatory multistakeholder workshops
 - Map stakeholders and on-going/planned activities
 - Create governing structure
 - Plan the implementation
- Currently some 15 or so UNECE Member States have expressed interest and/or started to develop ESD for 2030 country initiatives.





Next steps



- Country level preparatory workshop: Early 2021 onwards.
- Country submits country initiative plan: Early 2021 onwards.
- UNESCO World Conference on ESD: 17-19 May 2021. High-level ministerial session and plenary sessions to showcase country initiatives.
- Regional technical meeting : One week after Berlin Conference.

Europe and North America: Tuesday 25 May 14:30-16:00

- Regional meeting on ESD for 2030 : 2022. A physical meeting, back to back to regional SDG4 meeting where possible.
- Global ESD-Net meeting: Planned in 2023, cycle of once every 2 years.
