- Report “Measuring the performance of green economic development in the Republic of Moldova” (2017)
- Provided monitoring basis for the Road Map on Green Economy Promotion in Moldova

## New GGIs project in the Republic of Moldova

**Purpose:** Monitoring progress of the Republic of Moldova towards green growth

- Update/possible extension of the existing GGIs set
- Contribution to the preparation of the new Action Plan for the Programme on the promotion of green economy for 2022-24

**Key National Partners:** Ministry of Agriculture, Regional Development and Environment (MARDE), Ministry of Economy and Infrastructure (MEI), in collaboration with National Bureau of Statistics

**National Consultant:** Independent Think-Tank “Expert-Grup” (*contract is under preparation*)

### Key outputs:

- Development of an independent monitoring national report:
  - Update of 33 indicators, included in the 2017 report;
  - Link with the draft National Development Strategy “Moldova 2030”;
  - Proposal of specific actions for the Action Plan of the Program for 2022-2024 related to the update and maintenance of the process of GGIs monitoring and update;
  - Updated comparison table between the national set of GGIs, national SDGs and UNECE environmental set of indicators in Moldova
- Policy brief / highlights with key findings of the report
- Digitalization of the updated GGIs set (placing the updated set of indicators on the web site of MARDE)

## New GGIs project in Ukraine

**Purpose:** Measurement framework to evaluate progress towards greening the economy

- Review/update/possible extension of the existing GGIs set and identification of substitutes
- Contribution to the National Environmental Policy Strategy 2030 and EU Green Deal Initiative

**Key National Partners:** Ministries of Environment and of Economy and State Statistics Service

**National Consultant:** Resource and Analysis Center “Society and Environment”

### Key outputs:

- Development of national report:
  - Main part with 5 main thematic sections (5 areas of green growth);
  - Special part, covering 30 indicators of the National Environmental Policy Strategy till 2030
- “Nutshell” briefs with key findings of the report

**Duration:** mid-September 2021

- **New:** Collection of 2010-19 data on fossil fuel subsidies and inclusion of the EaP countries in the OECD-IEA database: important milestone in achieving transparency;
- Exploring further extension from country projects.

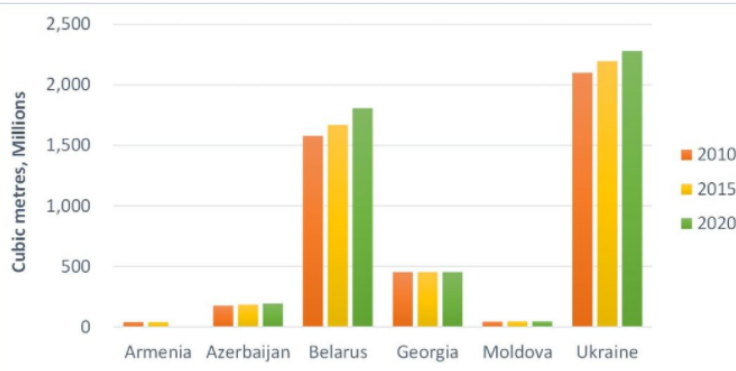
