Guidance notes: next steps



- 8 guidance notes will soon be sent for global consultation
 - Treatment of MNE and intra-MNE flows
 - Treatment of special purpose entities and residency
 - The development of Digital Supply and Use Tables
 - Distributions of household income, consumption, saving and wealth
 - Unpaid household service work
 - Health and social conditions
 - Economic ownership and depletion of natural resources
 - Labour accounts, education and human capital
- More to follow in autumn
- Guidance notes will be subject to baseline assessments to assess feasibility and certain ones to experimental estimates/testing
