RxSWIN - context

RxSWIN is defined in UN Regulation No. 156 (Software Update and Software Update Management System) – 1958 Agreement.

Why such a Regulation:

➤ Need for Software Updates

- Vehicles are getting connected
- Vehicle manufacturers intend to make SW updates (incl. OTA Over The Air) in order to add new functions (e.g. ADAS) on already registered vehicles

➤ Objective of the regulation

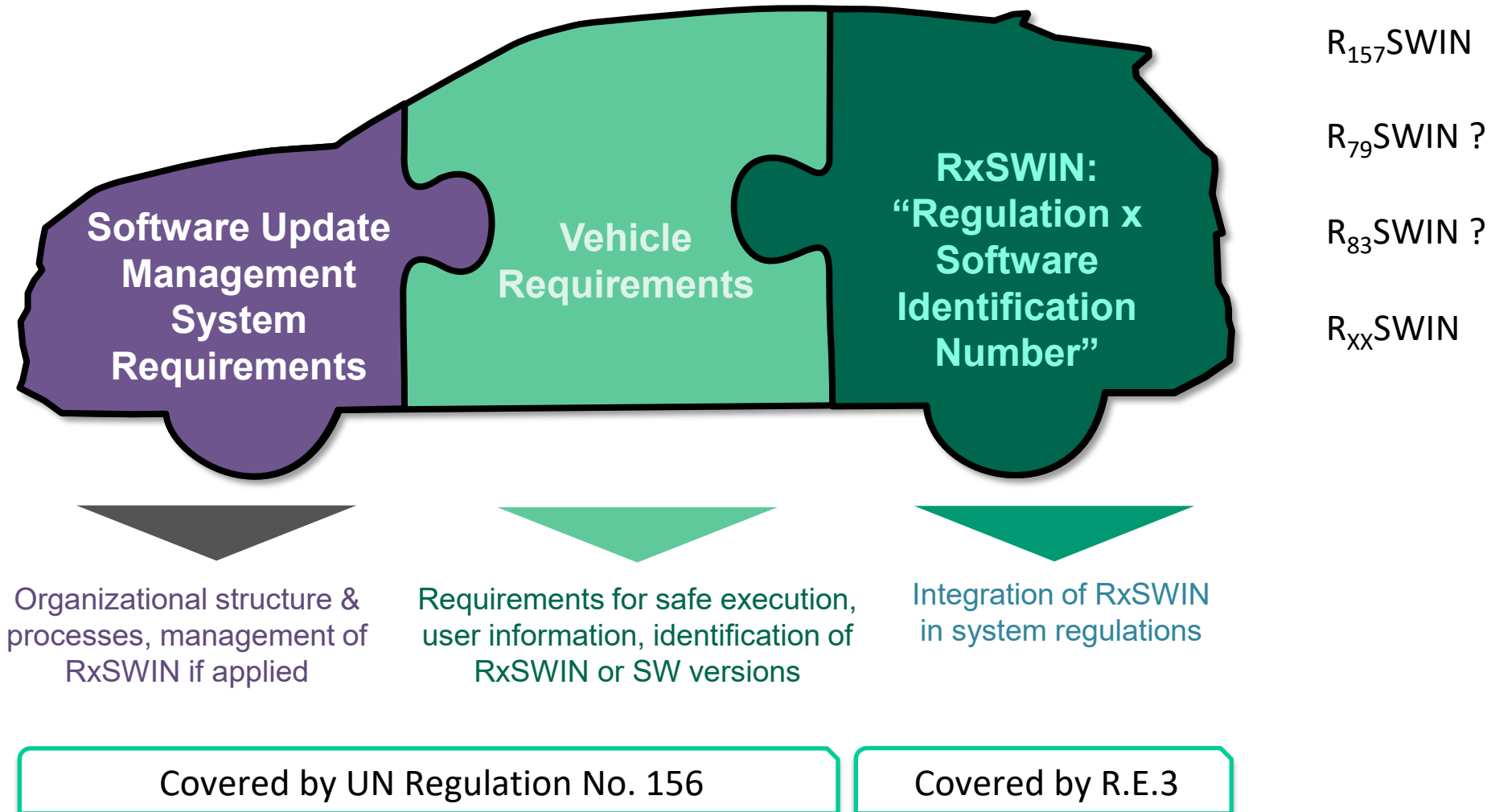
- Ensure that the SW on a vehicle is and stays compliant with vehicle type approval

RxSWIN - definition

"RX Software Identification Number (RXSWIN)" means:

- a dedicated identifier,
- defined by the vehicle manufacturer,
- representing **information** about the **type approval relevant software** of the Electronic Control System **contributing to UN Regulation N° X type approval relevant characteristics** of the vehicle

- Rx SWIN in the context of the 1998 Agreement
- Harmonize national/regional laws to allow for post-registration approval relevant updates
