
Transboundary water cooperation



TTTTTTT

More than 40% of the world population relies on shared basins for their livelihoods...

...but the majority of the 276 transboundary watercourses worldwide lacks an adequate cooperation framework.





The Water Convention



Objective

 Ensure protection and sustainable use of transboundary water resources through cooperation

Main pillars

- Prevent, control and reduce transboundary impact
- Ensure reasonable and equitable use of transboundary waters
- Cooperate through agreements and joint bodies

45 Parties to the Water Convention including 4 Parties from Africa

Guinea-Bissau acceded (45th Party)



Frequency


Meets every **three years** (MOP8 in 2018, Nur Sultan/ Kazakhstan)

Objective

Adopts the **programme of work** for the next three-year period

Participation

Representatives of Ministries from Parties and non-Parties, joint bodies, international and non-governmental organizations and academia


