I would like to draw your attention to the para 3 page 3 of the court's order (judgment) Mr Andriy Andrusevych referred to in his previous letter (please find attached), which indicates the actual nature of the event that took place on August 29, 2020. We have translated the above mentioned para:

“I come to the conclusion that the body conducting the administrative process and bringing the case for consideration correctly described the actions of the participants in the mass event, since they have all the signs of a rally listed in paragraph 5 of article 2 of the law, namely, there was a massive presence of citizens in a certain place with an open sky, gathered to publicly express their attitude to the events of social and political life”.

I would appreciate it if you take into consideration our comment when finalizing the draft report to the Decision VI/8c.
