- In February 2022 (dates TBC), back-to-back with the 75th Inland Transport Committee Anniversary (84th session), organized by the Sustainable Transport Division of UNECE
- Audience: UN Member States and partners, political leaders, participants to the 75th ITC Anniversary, organisations for road safety, young people, general public

- ➤ Raise awareness of road safety issues, particularly for young generations
- Advocacy for global, national and private investments in the field of road safety to promote greater mobilization of funds for road safety, including for the UNRSF
- ➤ Promote United Nations road safety legal instruments and encourage activities on road safety legal instruments in low and middle-income countries
- Visibility: promote the activities and work of LIFE, UNRSF, UNECE and partners

SELECTION OF THE BEST MOVIES

The Jury

A selection Committee, composed of Experts of Road Safety and Professionals of cinema, will nominate the films for short-listing to be shown during the public screening on the first day of the Festival. The Selection Committee will evaluate the films on the basis of explicit criteria:

- Intrinsic qualities (clarity and relevance of the message to the target adaptation, quality and originality of the script)
- Technical qualities (sound, sound design, image editing)

The Public Award

One "Public Award" will be decerned for the category "Moments2Live4".

An online poll / vote system on UNRSF social media profiles will give the public the opportunity to participate in the selection of the best films.
