Progress to date

- WP.1 secretariat has been working with WHO and other Regional Commissions to prepare this plan since end of 2020 (the Taskforce)
- Country/NGO consultations in April-May 2021
- Draft plan was revised several times to take into account feedback received from countries, NGOs, and Taskforce members.
- Plan has been finalized in recent weeks, and annexes are being finalized.
