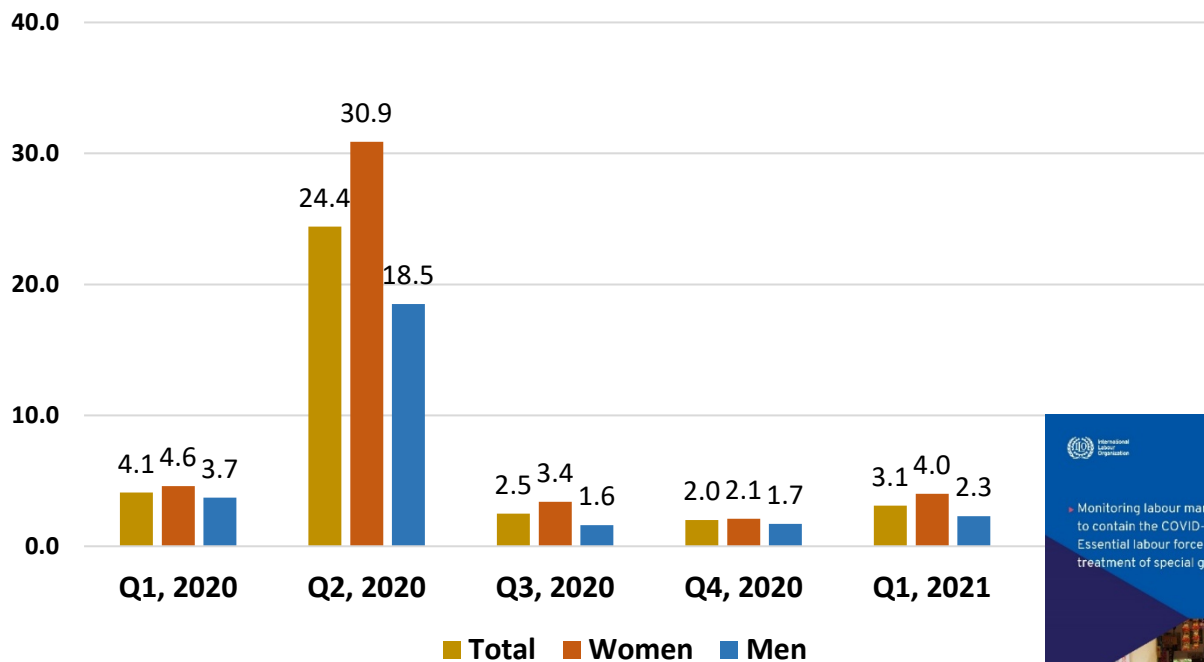

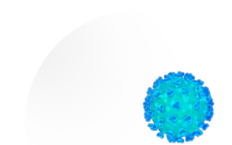

(% of total persons affected by COVID-19)





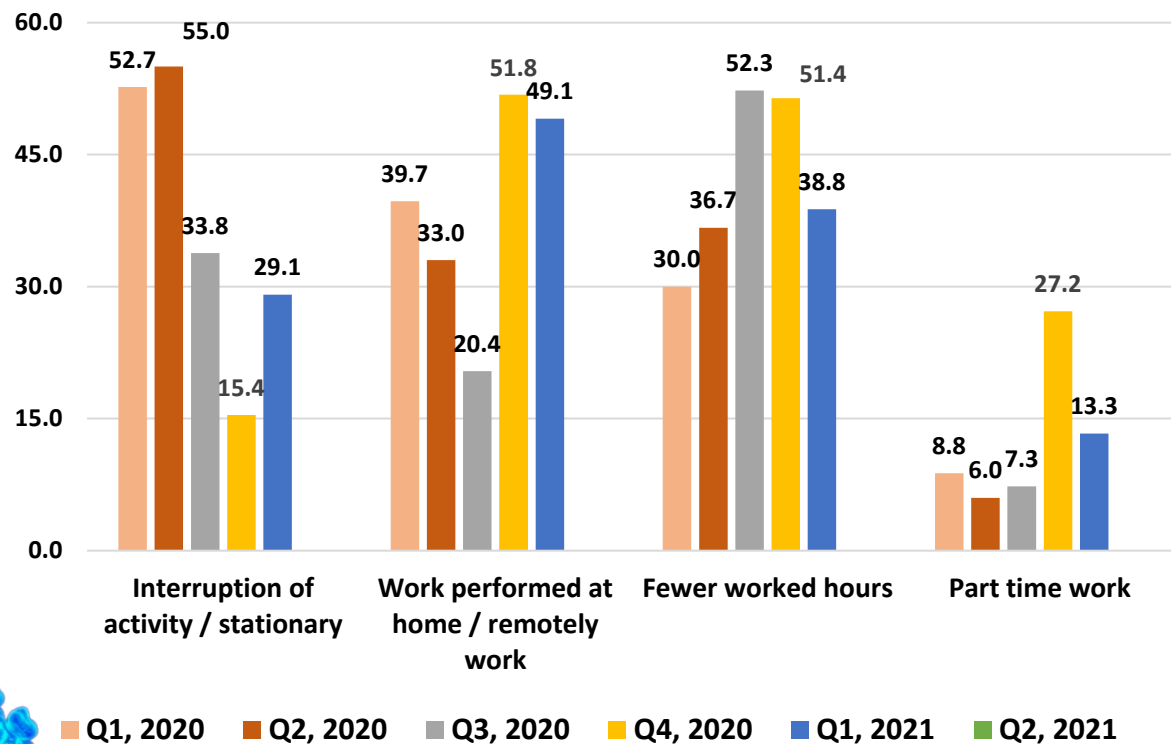

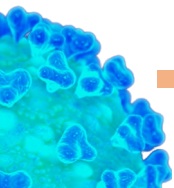
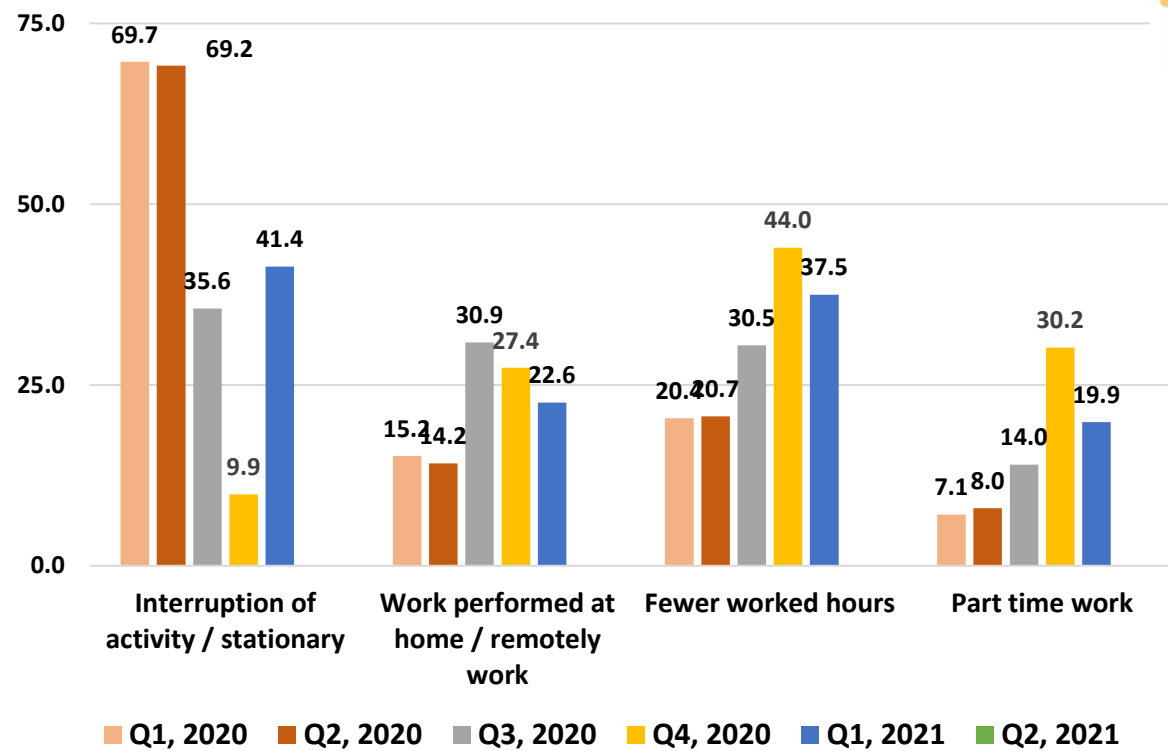
Women predominantly in almost all categories of situations caused by Covid-19, but especially among those who work **remotely** & which worked **fewer hours**

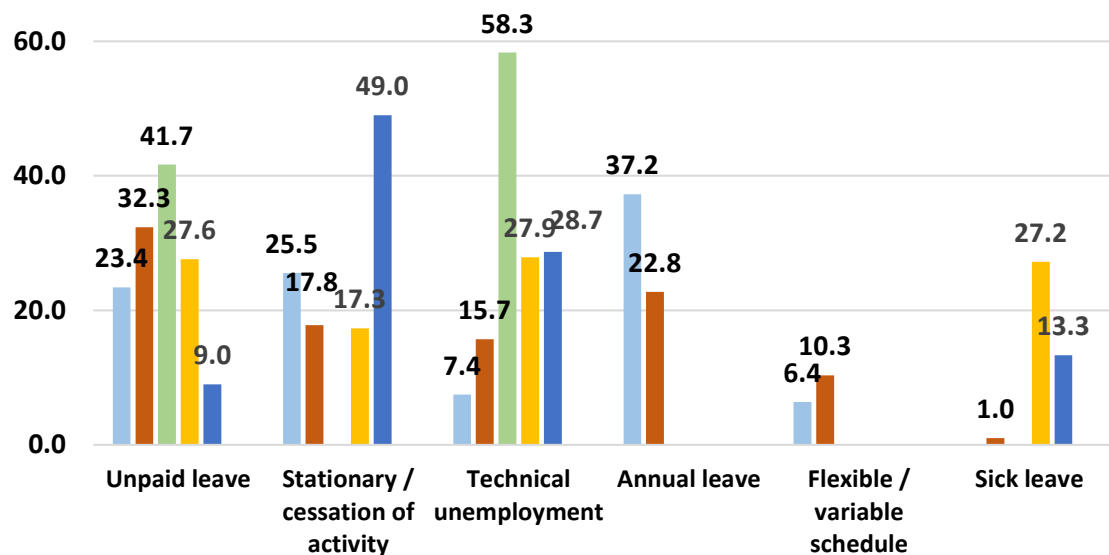
Main reasons of absence for both, women and men



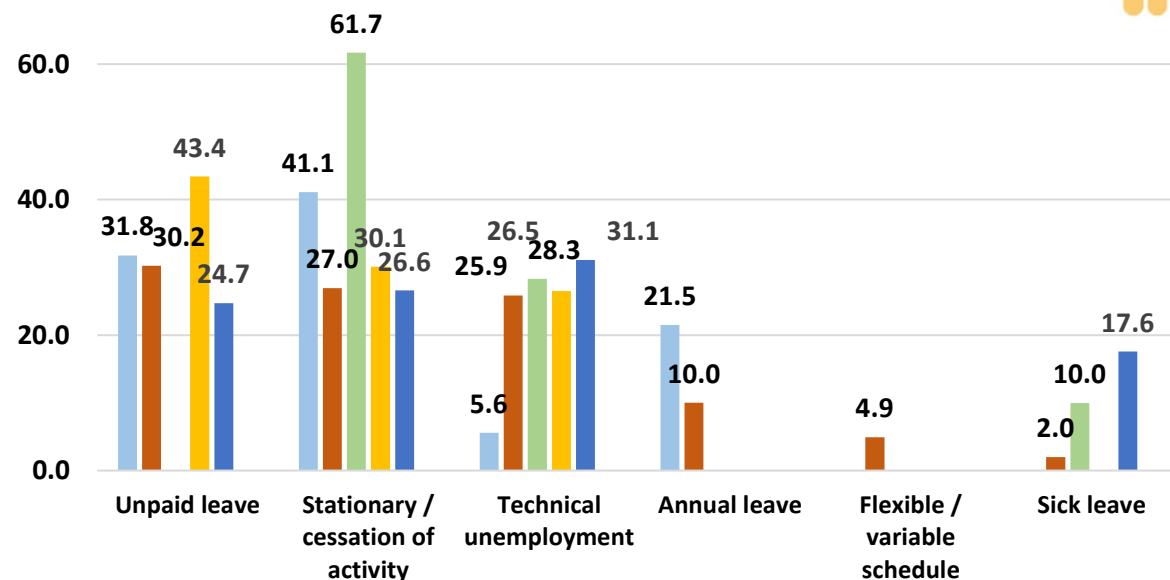
Type of absences, as share in total absences from work due to COVID-19 by sex, 2020

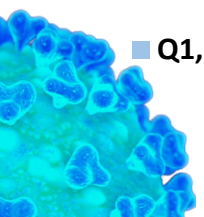

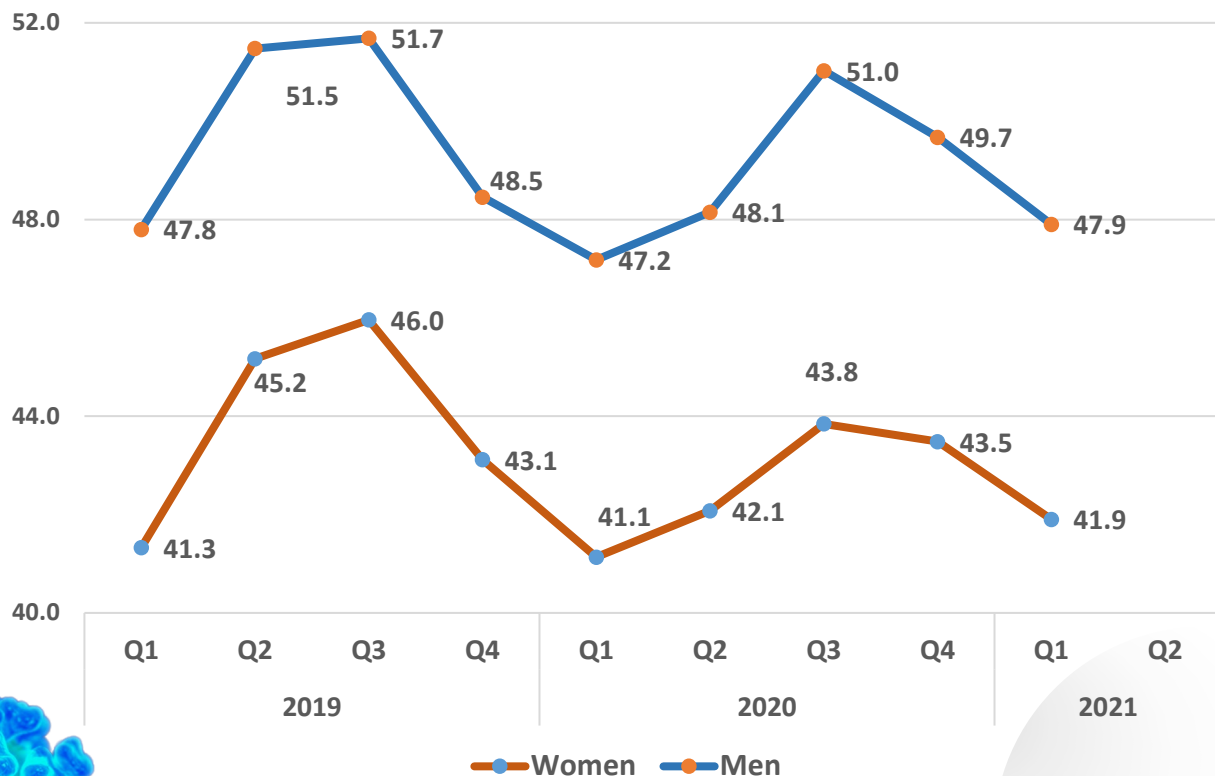

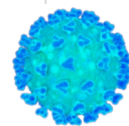

Unemployment rate, 15 years + %



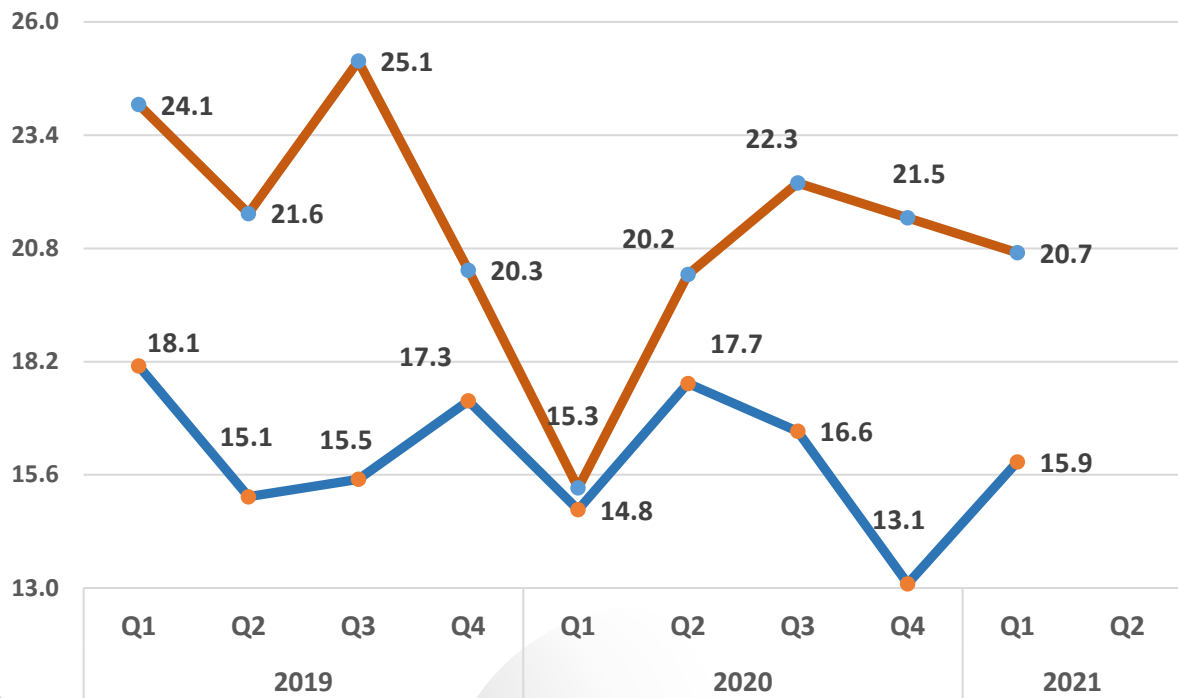

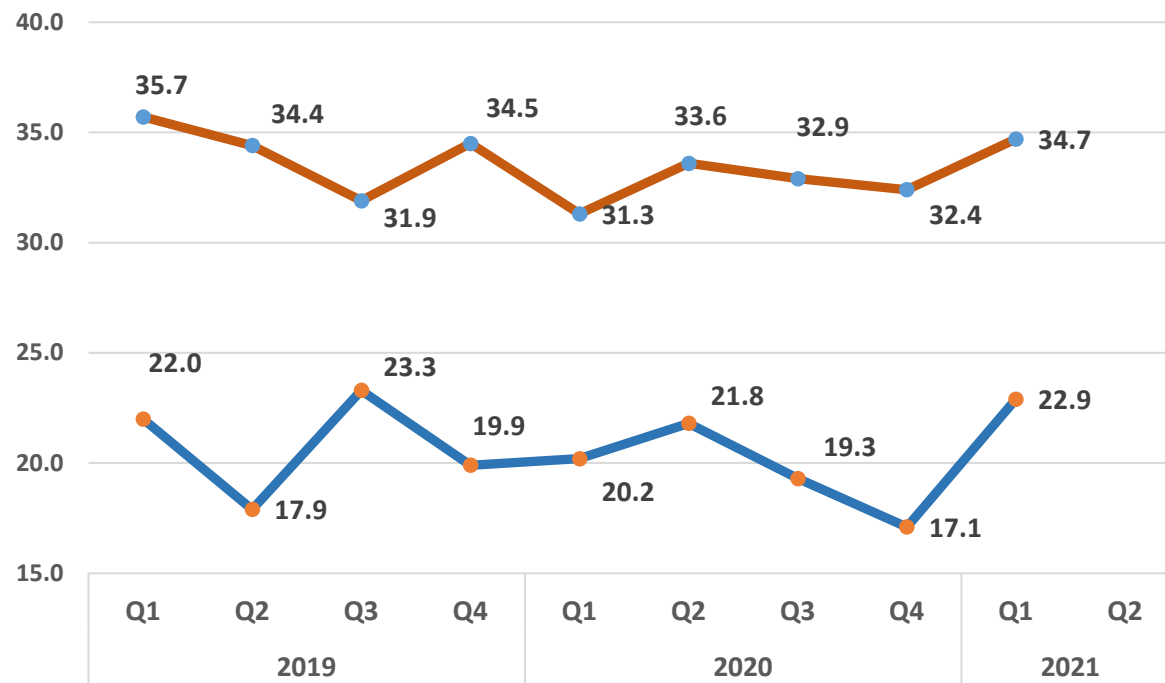

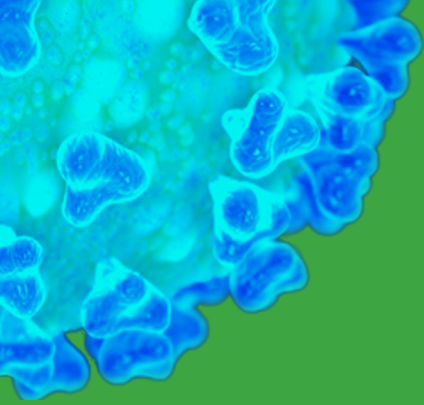

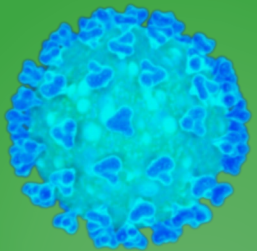

Use of gender statistics during Covid-19



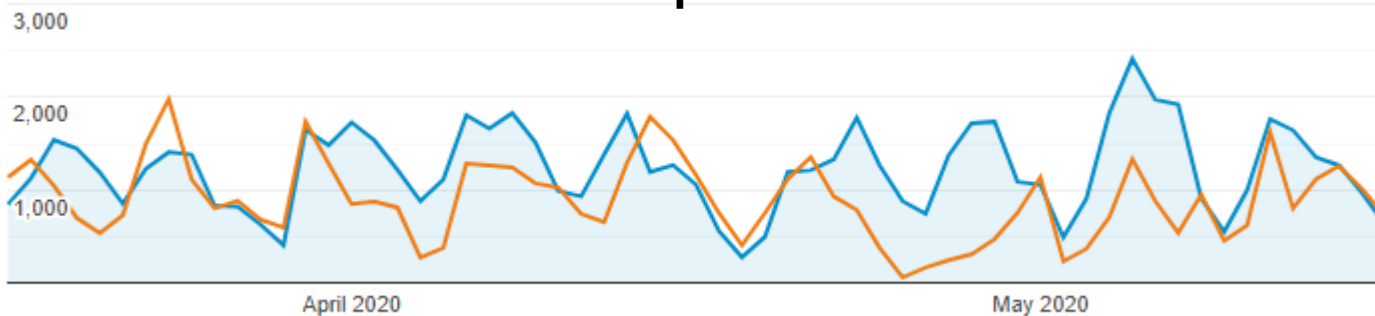

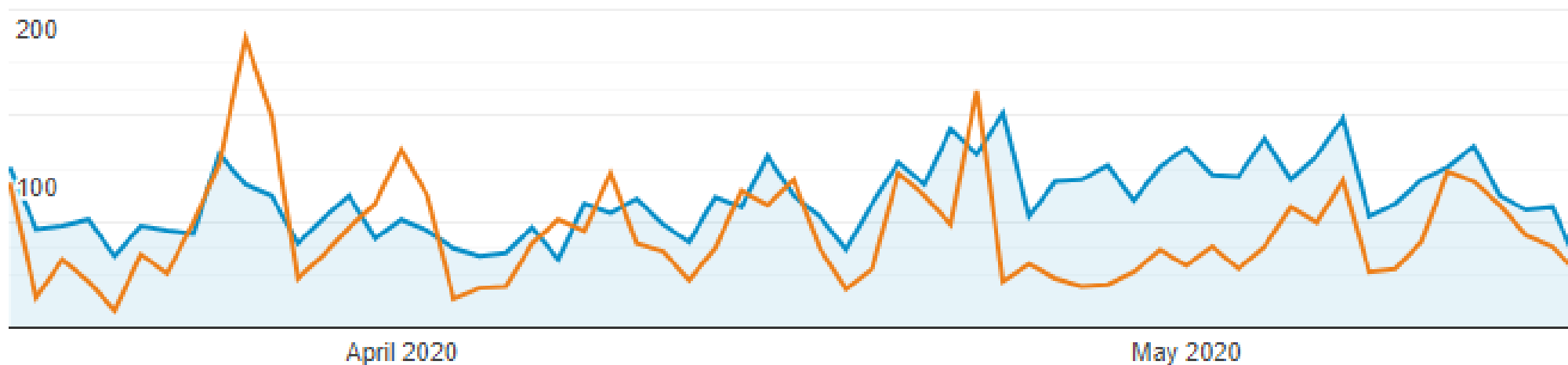

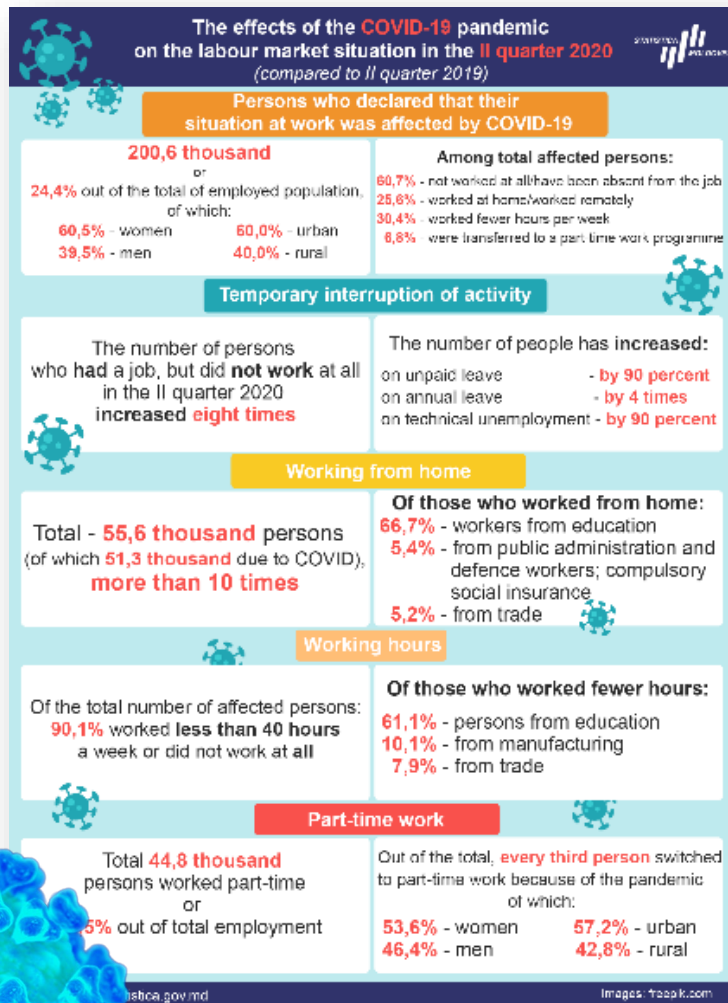

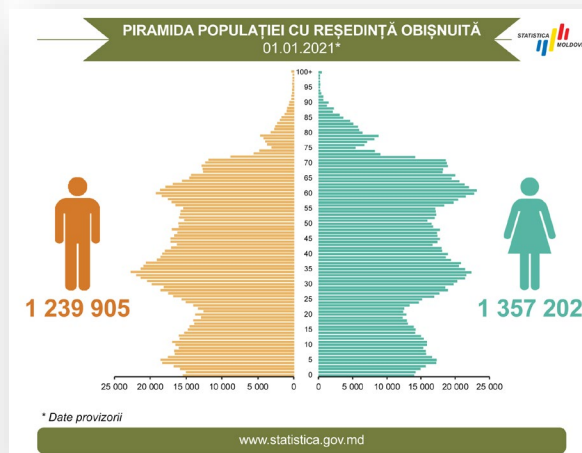
