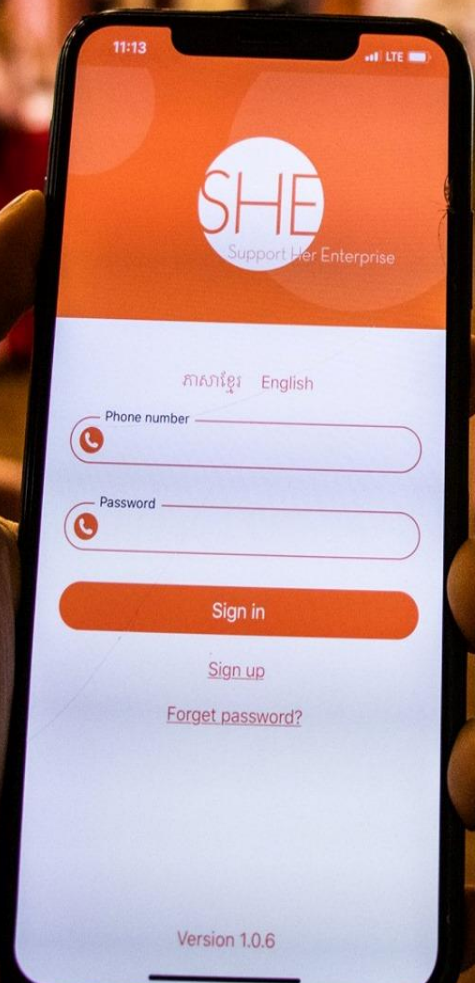

Key messages
