Since the Meeting of Parties held in 2017, the situation has aggravated. More and more persons exercising environmental rights are persecuted or harassed. The most alarming examples can be witnessed in Belarus, but similar infringements happen in other countries, including the EU member states. The global pandemic has contributed to the negative development: some states have begun to restrict democratic mechanisms in legislation. The side event will present the situation in the region. Discussion will focus on what can be done to alleviate the pressure on defenders and how the existing human rights mechanisms and planned Rapid Response Mechanism could help.
