## Decisions of the 11<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Task Force on Water and Climate

- Encouraged countries to mainstream transboundary aspects of water management into their national climate-related documents such as, for example, Nationally Determined Contributions (NDCs) and National Adaptation Plans (NAPs), and to liaise with colleagues responsible for climate change issues and disaster risk reduction;
- Encouraged the participants to apply the findings of the background paper *Mainstreaming* water and transboundary cooperation into climate-related documents into their work to
  mainstream the central role of water and the benefits of transboundary cooperation into
  climate-related documents:
- Encouraged the participants to submit their suggestions for future activities on climate change adaptation in transboundary basins in the framework of the planned survey on the next programme of work for 2022-2024 under the Water Convention;
- Decided to organize the twelfth meeting the Task Force on Water and Climate back-to-back with the global workshop on climate change adaptation with a focus on health in cooperation with the Protocol on Water and Health on 29-31 March 2020.
