

### **Decisions of the 11<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Task Force on Water and Climate**

- Encouraged countries to **mainstream transboundary aspects of water management into their national climate-related documents** such as, for example, Nationally Determined Contributions (NDCs) and National Adaptation Plans (NAPs), and to liaise with colleagues responsible for climate change issues and disaster risk reduction;
- Encouraged the participants to apply the findings of the background paper ***Mainstreaming water and transboundary cooperation into climate-related documents*** into their work to mainstream the central role of water and the benefits of transboundary cooperation into climate-related documents;
- Encouraged the participants to submit their **suggestions for future activities on climate change adaptation in transboundary basins in the framework of the planned survey** on the next programme of work for 2022-2024 under the Water Convention;
- Decided to organize the **twelfth meeting the Task Force on Water and Climate back-to-back with the global workshop** on climate change adaptation with a focus on health in cooperation with the Protocol on Water and Health on **29-31 March 2020**.
