



Objectives of the workshop

The UNECE secretariat is developing a project on strengthening the capacity of Central Asian countries to develop sustainable urban mobility policy on car sharing and car-pooling initiatives. The aim is to improve the understanding of national policy makers on the core requirements for the introduction of such initiatives, and to improve their capacity to develop and implement the relevant sustainable transport policies. This project reviews experiences from various countries and identifies the good practices and lessons learned from urban mobility, car sharing and car-pooling initiatives to provide Central Asian countries with best practices on how to set up and regulate such schemes.

During this workshop, the first project's outputs will be presented to Central Asian countries. The car sharing desktop analysis will give an overview of the current situation and the guidelines on developing and implementing sustainable transport policies will be discussed.
