

The Reform of the Kazakhstan's mineral and raw material complex has been started in July 2018 with the introduction of the new Code "On Subsoil and Subsoil Use"

The Code "On Subsoil and Subsoil Use

liberalized subsoil use procedures and consolidated the transition to CRIRSCO standards for Solid minerals

radically simplified licensing procedures

the principle of the first application "first come first received" was introduced, the terms were significantly reduced

greatly facilitated access to historical geological information

the interactive map of subsoil use, available online, was introduced

On the readiness of Kazakhstan to increase the development of the country's mineral and raw material complex

The Code of the Republic of Kazakhstan

on Subsoil and Subsoil Use

new licenses for Solid minerals, mainly for prospecting and exploration work

- A large part of new licenses have been issued to junior companies for «green field» prospecting and exploration.
- Thus, the fact that the investment attractiveness of subsoil use in the Republic of Kazakhstan increased is obvious.








The Geology Committee accepts reports prepared by PONEN Competent Persons in accordance with

Resources and reserves estimated in accordance with the KAZRC Code were put on the State balance sheet, including several objects, for the first time









Due to the widespread use of CRIRSCO standards, the requirements for quality control and reliability of exploration work have significantly increased.

In exploration programs, all subsoil users, without exception, provide for standard QA / QC procedures

to create conditions for a significant improvement in the management of the development of the Mineral and Raw Materials Complex of Kazakhstan







at the first stage:



- organize a discussion of the Concept at the Geological Subcommittee of the National Chamber of Entrepreneurs Atameken,


with the creation of a Working Group to develop a Roadmap and Implementation Program for the UNFC and UNRMS,
