<u>Geneva Declaration on Environmental Democracy for Sustainable, Inclusive and Resilient</u> Development

The UK would like to propose the following amendment to paragraph 18:

"18. We note that the vast majority of the Parties to the Aarhus Convention and to the Protocol are involved in the engage with China's Belt and Road Initiative, the transcontinental long-term policy and investment programme that aims at infrastructure development and acceleration of the economic integration of countries along the route of the historic Silk Road an economic and foreign policy and investment programme that aims to support regional cooperation and connectivity. Putting safeguards in place through national legislation, international agreements and financial and compliance instruments is critical to ensuring sustainable development. We call on Parties to ensure that the obligations under both the Aarhus Convention and the Protocol are fully adhered to in implementing when engaging with the Belt and Road Initiative."
