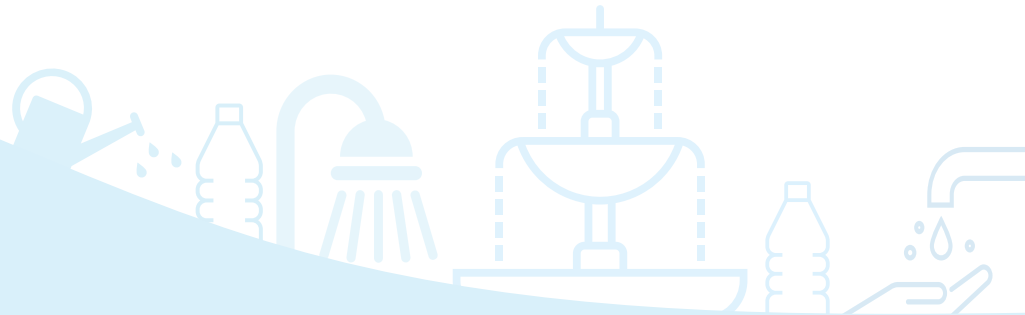




MAIN OBJECTIVES OF THIS TASK FORCE MEETING


- Launch the 5th Reporting Cycle under the Protocol and discuss the preparations needed

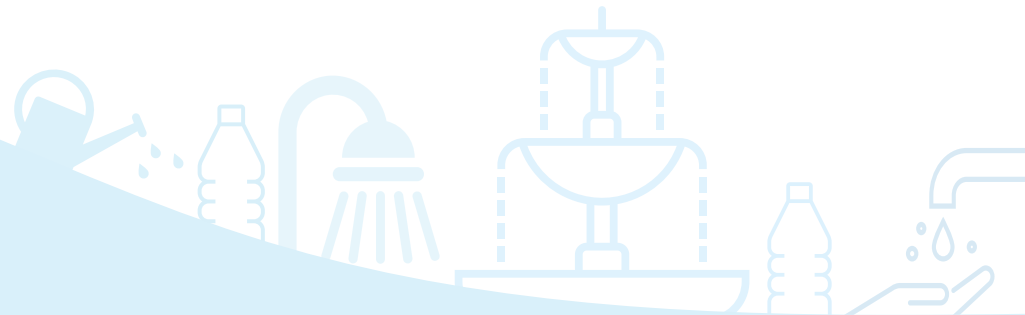
13th meeting of the Working Group on Water and Health (Geneva and hybrid)
