# During 2020 IMI-SDG6 conducted its second global data drive



## 2020 Data Drive

UN sends data request to countries / estimates based on open data

Country compiles / validate data and submit to UN

UN validates data together with country

Country signoff and publication of data

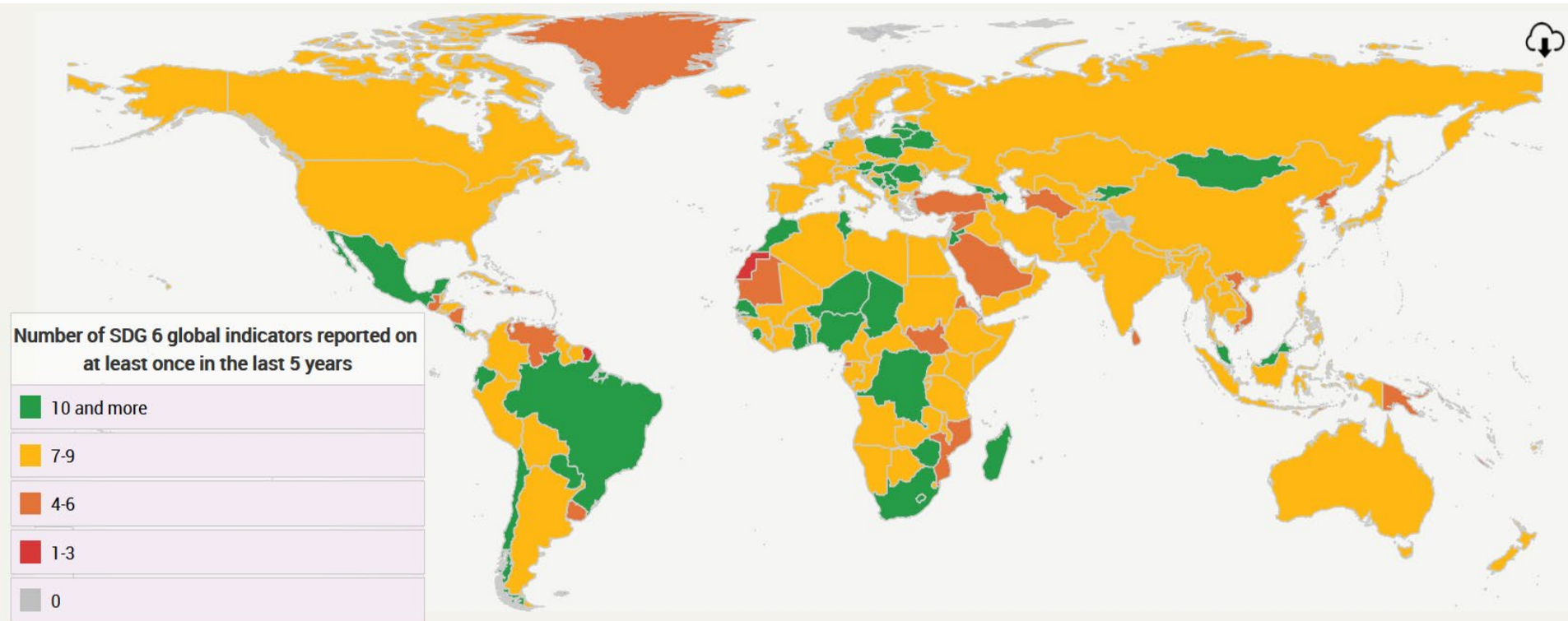
## Support to countries

- Guidance on data collection and reporting (e.g. methodologies)
- Online support (e.g. helpdesk, webinars and e-learning, focal point database, collection of good practices)
- Face-to-face support (e.g. country visits, regional/global workshops)
- Data and progress reporting (e.g. SDG 6 Data Portal)

# Despite the global pandemic, we saw an increase in the reporting of the global indicators

- Progress needs to quadruple (x4)

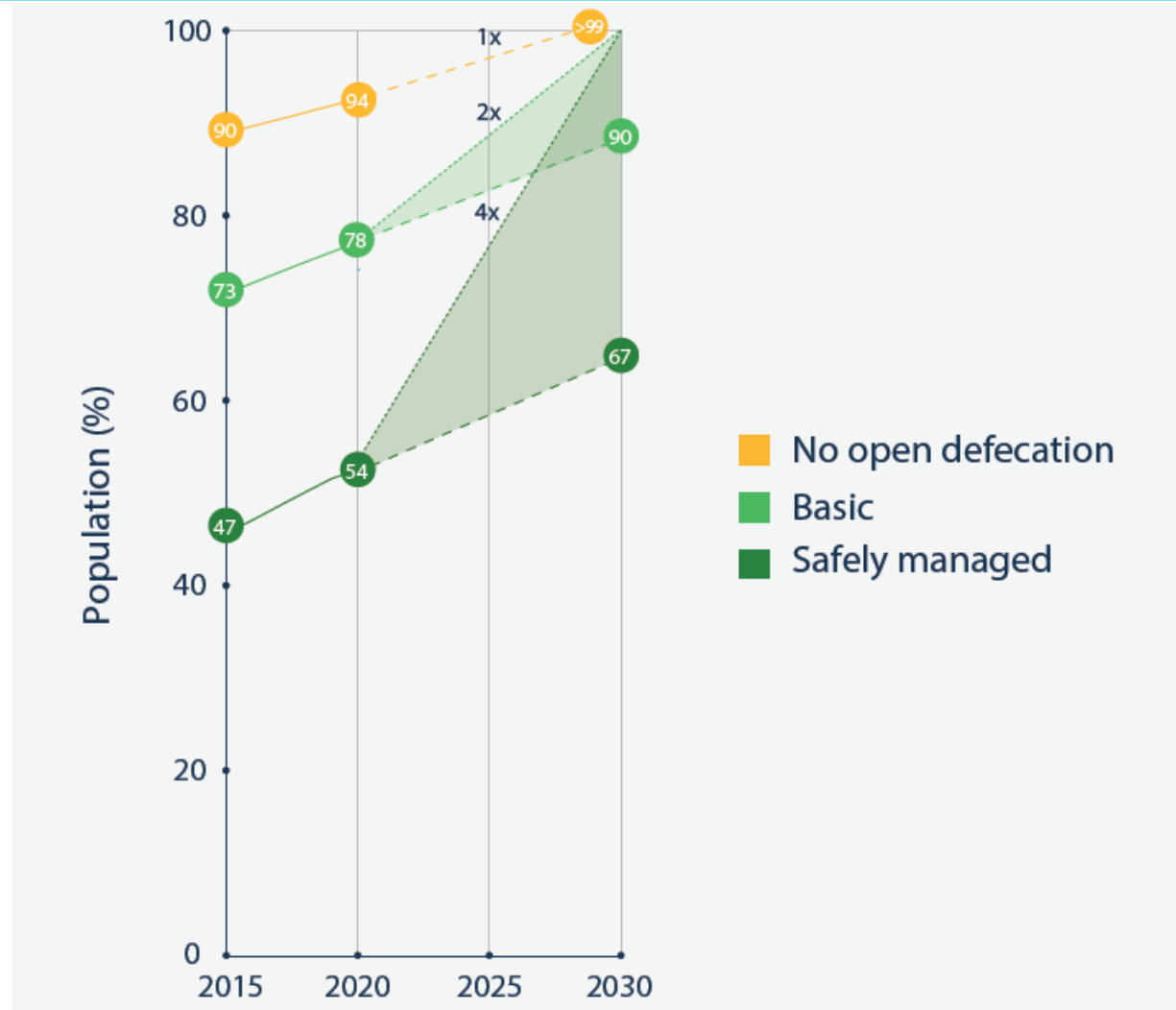

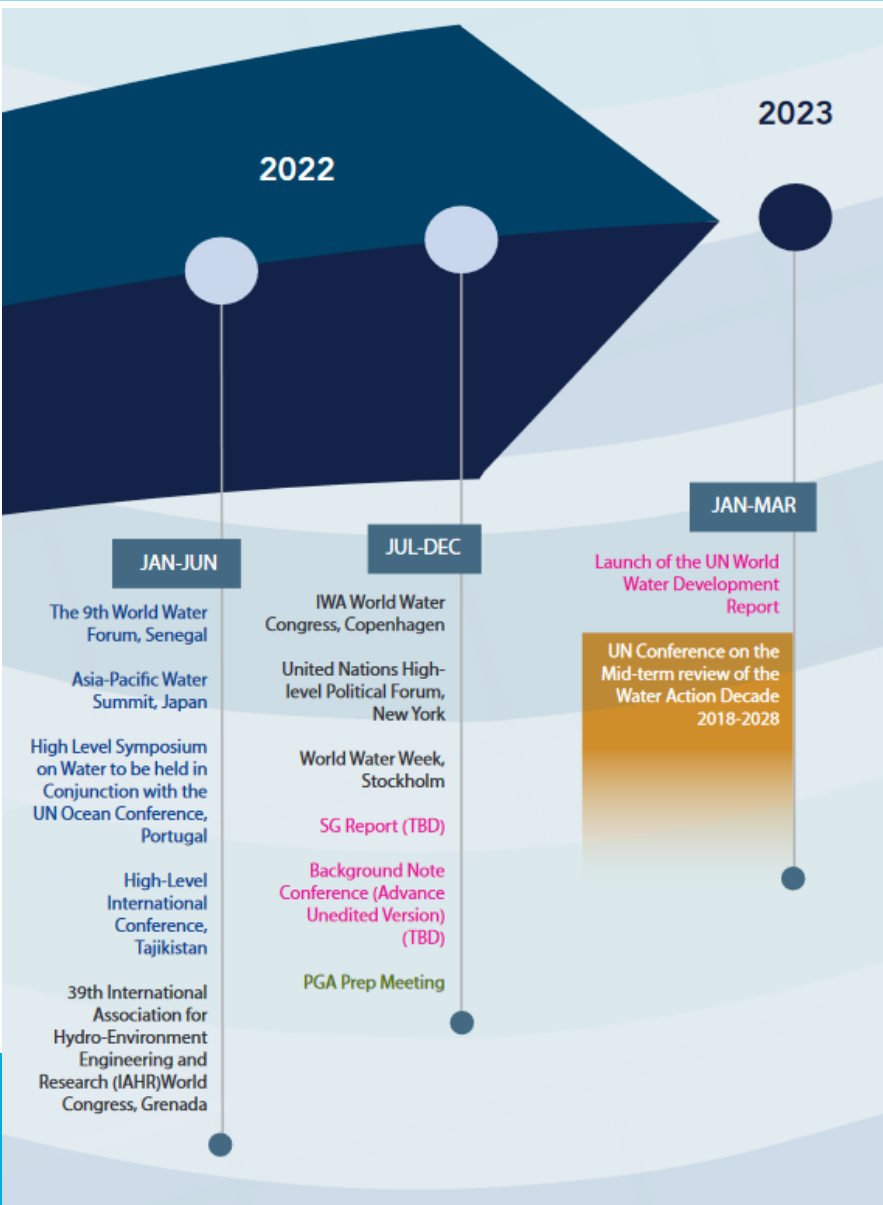
# The main message was that we need to accelerate progress
