## **Decisions relating to the Committee on Sustainable Energy**

### **Background**

- 1. At its thirtieth session (Geneva, 22–24 September 2021), the Committee on Sustainable Energy:
- (a) endorsed the revised strategic review of the sustainable energy subprogramme (ECE/ENERGY/2021/4);
- (b) adopted the proposed draft programme of work of the sustainable energy subprogramme for 2022 (ECE/ENERGY/2021/1);
- (c) approved the renewal of the mandates of the Groups of Experts on Cleaner Electricity Systems, on Energy Efficiency, on Gas and on Renewable Energy for the period 2022–2023 with the possibility of extension (ECE/ENERGY/137); and
- (d) approved the change of name of the Group of Experts on Coal Mine Methane, its revised terms of reference and its renewal of mandate, as contained in document ECE/ENERGY/2021/13.
