**Project title:** Towards 2030: Strengthening mechanisms for peer learning and policy exchange on sustainable development in the UNECE region (RFSD 2022)

Expected timing/duration: January - July 2022

#### Objective and brief summary of the project:

The project aims to strengthen the capacity of UNECE member States to implement the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development by providing an annual platform for peer learning and policy exchange. The Regional Forum on Sustainable Development has become the prominent platform for practical peer learning on SDG solutions in the region, bringing together representatives from member States as well as civil society, academia and international organizations.

The objective of the project will be achieved by implementing the following activity:

A1.1.Organization of the annual Regional Forum on Sustainable Development for the UNECE region, consisting of a high-level dialogue and thematic round tables to enhance peer learning and policy exchange among UNECE member States and other stakeholders, including civil society the private sector and academia, in Geneva in 2022.

### **Expected results of the project:**

EA1. Enhanced policy dialogue and peer learning on sustainable development in the UNECE region by organizing the Regional Forum on Sustainable Development in 2022.

## Target group and beneficiaries of the project:

Target group: UNECE policymakers in areas related to sustainable development, other international organizations, civil society, busines and academia. Beneficiary countries are UNECE member States.

#### Justification of project and its relationship to the programme of work:

At its 67th session (26-27April 2017), the Commission decided to establish the Regional Forum on Sustainable Development for the UNECE region, which while retaining its intergovernmental character, would serve as a regional mechanism to follow up and review the implementation of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development (Decision B(67), E/2017/37, E/ECE/1480). At its 69<sup>th</sup> session (20-21 April 2021), the Commission (Decision C(69), E/2021/37, E/ECE/1494) decided to continue to convene annual sessions of the Regional Forum in the years 2022 and 2023, in close cooperation with the entities of the regional United Nations system and with the active engagement of other relevant stakeholders.
