

- Interparliamentary Youth Assembly of the CIS Member States.















SDG 1 and SDG 10 monitoring challenges

- Incomparability of data between countries for a number of indicators.
 - indicator 1.3.1. Proportion of population covered by minimal thresholds/social protection systems;
 - indicator 10.1.1. Growth rate of household expenditures or per capita income among the poorest 40% of the population and across the overall population.
- Lack of continuous time series.
- Indicators that are difficult to develop.
 - indicator 1.4.1. Proportion of the population living in households with access to basic services.
