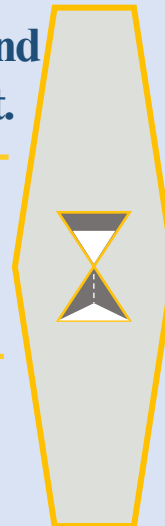
The Generic Law on Official Statistics developed by the UNECE for Eastern Europe, the Caucasus and Central Asia and approved on April 29, 2016.

The main disadvantages of the Law “On State Statistics” (Adopted in 2002)

Only the activities of state statistics bodies were regulated, and other producers of statistical data were not taken into account.

The tasks and functions of other governmental bodies that produce statistics in the country were not defined.

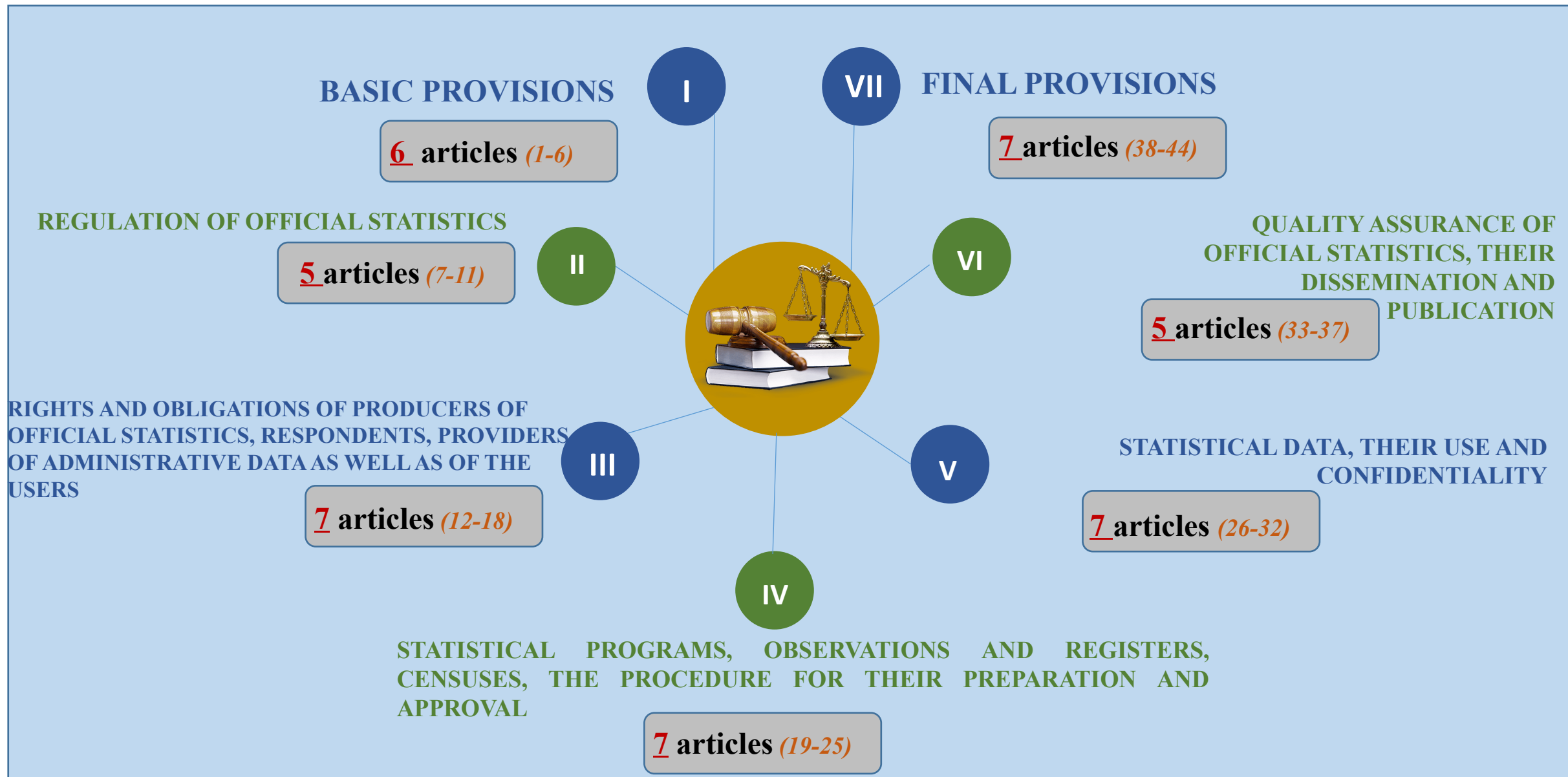
There was no an authorized body in the field of statistics coordinating the activities of all data producers.



The procedures for the production, use and publication of statistics for all producers have not been established

There were no definitions of the basic concepts used in the field of statistics.

The legal status of administrative data and their difference from statistical data used in the activities of state bodies have not been determined.



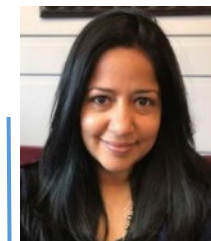
