








- <u>26th session of the SPECA Working Group on Sustainable Transport, Transit and Connectivity the platform that fosters cooperation and enhances regional dialogue while being a knowledge and good practices sharing point for inland transport;</u>
- This year meeting will be held on 25/11/2021 with focus on regional connectivity (infrastructure development, removing of bottlenecks), international transport (border crossing facilitation and corridor management), road safety and Programme of work 2022-23;
- SPECA Workshop on digitalization of transport services (eTIR and eCMR) is planed back-to-back with WG STTC;
- Countries should further support this group and especially the development of the SPECA Transport Connectivity Strategy.



The eTIR international system aims to ensure the secure exchange of data between national Customs the related systems international transit of goods, vehicles or containers according to the provisions of the TIR Convention and to allow Customs to manage the data on guarantees, issued by guarantee chains to holders authorized to use the TIR system (Customs to Customs).




