Database for the Exchange of Approval documentation

DETA

The secure internet database for exchanging approval documentation between the Contracting Parties of the 1958 Agreement, as required to be established by the
UNECE,
according to Revision 3 of this Agreement.

State of play

- **DETA is still under development but since May 2019 ready to be used for its base purpose:**
- **33 Contracting Parties** have notified their DETA Focal Point
- App. **12400 approvals** uploaded (**13 CP**)
- App. **5560 manufacturers** are uploaded and could be selected by TAA
- **13 Manufacturer** have access to DETA (only to their own approvals)
(manufacturer's access is to be requested via their approval authority and to be forwarded to the DETA Administrator)

State of play – Developments – state of play

- **Contracting and implementation UI**
 - contract for financial participation of industry is drafted
- **Mass Upload Functionality**
 - purchase order finalized in KBA
- **Two factor authentication**
 - proposal of SW-house under review

State of play – Extension of scope

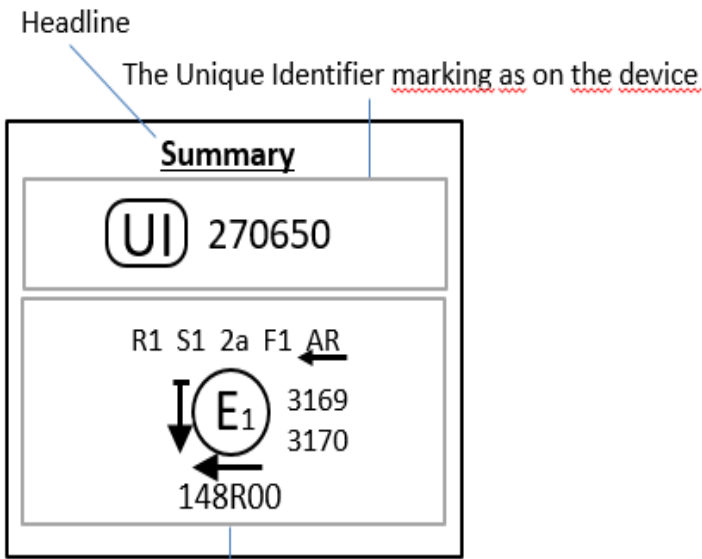
- **Extension of scope DETA following WP.29/AC.2 assignment**

- The IWG on DETA discussed the proposal to extend DETA to store the ‘traffic scenarios catalogue for automated vehicles’:
 - The access to the traffic scenarios catalogue is beneficial to all CPs to the 1958 and 1998 Agreements;
 - If agreed by WP.29, the IWG on DETA will investigate the possibilities and work in conjunction with the IWG on VMAD/SG1 to deliver the proper solutions for the description of traffic scenarios;
 - The intention is to provide access to the traffic scenarios for stakeholders to allow them building their own concrete scenarios from the available elements relevant to the scenario layers;
 - This proposal may contribute to unblock DETA financing from the UN budget.
