

Summary At its 25th session, the Working Party noted that Recommendation F: "Creation and Promotion of International Agreements on Conformity Assessment" - adopted by the Working Party in 1980, and lat revised in 1983 - retained its validity but needed to be updated taking into consideration developments in this area. 




