Prevention of industrial accidents and incidents at hazardous facilities

Monitoring the implementation of legislation, incl. international obligations



- ✓ Pressure equipment and thermal power plants
- ✓ Lifting equipment and attractions
- ✓ Gas supply systems and trunk line pipelines
- ✓ Chemical industry, grain processing and ammonia refrigeration
- ✓ Mining and blasting operations, metallurgical production, disposal of ammunition
- ✓ Transportation of dangerous goods
