




Plan for developing national policy guiding principles



Way forward:

Support the development of **national policy guiding principles** (NPGP)

Develop national strategies tailored to the region

NPGP to provide an **enabling framework** for the implementation and monitoring of successful and sustainable FLR activities







Plan for developing national policy guiding principles



Process

Support 2 pilot countries to develop national strategies based on the NPGP

Prepare a draft NPGP in collaboration with countries









Regional FLR policy dialogue to be held on Wednesday 9 February 2022

- Draft NPGP will be discussed and endorsed at a regional policy dialogue to take place on 9 February 2022
- Advancement of the 2 pilot national strategies and of a capacity building package will be presented
- Presentation of the <u>FAO FLR Mechanism</u> and opportunities for its support toward large scale FLR
- Discussion on further steps toward FLR implementation in the region










Expected benefits

- NPGP will facilitate access to funding and will increase the visibility on a global scale of FLR efforts in the region
- NPGP will help to get a broader and sustainable stakeholders' support in FLR activities











Capacity building approach

- Use and adaptation of existing capacity building contents from FAO and IUCN
- Develop a curriculum based on a coaching approach (regular backstopping sessions over one year)
- Initiate the capacity building process with a regional capacity building workshop - End of February 2022
- Follow-up coaching sessions with interested countries
