Subject: Decision VII/8g (Germany) - Invitation to open session at Committee's 73rd meeting on preparing Germany's plan of action – next Tuesday, 14 December, 12.00-13.00 CET

Dear Mr. Sauer,

I hope that you are well.

As you may recall, under paragraph 3 (a) of decision VII/8g adopted by the Meeting of the Parties at its seventh session, Germany must submit a plan of action, including a time schedule, to the Committee by 1 July 2022 regarding the implementation of the recommendation in paragraph 2 of the decision.

Each of the Parties that are subject to a decision on compliance adopted by the Meeting of the Parties at its seventh session must likewise prepare a plan of action by the same date. Following enquiries from several Parties as to what their plan of action should look like, the Compliance Committee has agreed to hold an open session **next Tuesday, 14 December, from 12.00-13.00 CET**, during its seventy-third meeting, in order to provide guidance to Parties on the required content and format of their plans of action.

In addition to presentations by the Committee and secretariat to assist Parties to understand the format, content, and level of detail the required plan of action should include, there will also be opportunities for Parties to ask any questions and seek clarification from the Committee.

The representatives of Germany who will be involved in preparation of the plan of action are thus strongly encouraged to participate in the session. Communicants and observers are also welcome to attend the session.

I would be grateful if you would confirm **by noon CET this coming Thursday, 9 December**, that Germany will take part in the session.
