Subject: Decision VII/8c (Belarus) - Invitation to open session at Committee's 73rd meeting on preparing Belarus' plan of action – next Tuesday, 14 December, 12.00-13.00 CET

Dear Ms. Lukina,

I hope that you are well.

As you may recall, under paragraph 10 of decision VII/8c adopted by the Meeting of the Parties at its seventh session, Belarus is requested to submit a plan of action, including a time schedule, to the Committee by 1 July 2022 regarding the implementation of the recommendations in paragraphs 2, 3 and 9 of decision VII/8c.

Each of the Parties that are subject to a decision on compliance adopted by the Meeting of the Parties at its seventh session must likewise prepare a plan of action by the same date. Following enquiries from several Parties as to what their plan of action should look like, the Compliance Committee has agreed to hold an open session **next Tuesday, 14 December, from 12.00-13.00 CET**, during its seventy-third meeting, in order to provide guidance to Parties on the required content and format of their plans of action.

In addition to presentations by the Committee and secretariat to assist Parties to understand the format, content, and level of detail the required plan of action should include, there will also be opportunities for Parties to ask any questions and seek clarification from the Committee.

The representatives of Belarus who will be involved in the preparation of the plan of action are thus strongly encouraged to take part in the open session. Communicants and observers are also welcome to attend the session.

The open session will be held in English, with interpretation in Russian and French provided. The provisional timeline for the Committee's seventy-third meeting is available at:
