
#### Annotated provisional agenda for the fourteenth meeting

#### II. Annotations to the provisional agenda

#### 1. Election of officers

Tentative timing: Thursday, 24 February, 3–3.55 p.m.

- 1. In accordance with paragraph 7 of annex I to decision VI/1 of the Meeting of the Parties to the Convention on the Protection and Use of Transboundary Watercourses and International Lakes (Water Convention) (see ECE/MP.WAT/37/Add.2), at its ninth session (Geneva (hybrid), 29 September–1 October 2021), the Meeting of the Parties proceeded with the election of four Committee members. Ms. Dinara Ziganshina was re-elected for a full term. Mr. Attila Tanzi was re-elected for half a term. The following new members were elected for a full term: Ms. Jovanka Ignjatovic and Mr. Makane Moïse Mbengue.
- 2. The members will each be invited to briefly introduce themselves and to spell out their vision of how they can contribute to the Committee's work in the period 2022–2024.
- 3. In accordance with paragraph 10 of annex I to decision VI/1, the Implementation Committee is expected to elect its chair and vice-chair.

- 5. In accordance with the relevant procedures set out in paragraph 15 (a)–(c) of annex I to decision VI/1 of the Meeting of the Parties to the Convention, the Committee is expected to consider:
- (a) Any request for advice by a Party or Parties relating to specific issues concerning difficulties in implementation or application of the Convention;
- (b) Any submission by Parties relating to specific issues concerning difficulties in implementation and compliance;
  - (c) Undertaking a Committee initiative.
- 6. In particular, the Committee will be briefed by the Water Convention focal points from Montenegro and Albania on progress made with the implementation of the Committee's legal and technical advice under advisory procedure WAT/IC/AP/1 (ECE/MP.WAT/IC/2021/1, annex). It may hold further consultations with the two countries and may agree on the next steps and responsibilities in providing advisory assistance.

#### 4. Cooperation with other committees and organizations

7. The Committee will discuss cooperation with other implementation and compliance bodies, such as that of the Protocol on Water and Health, and exchange views on this issue

The Implementation Committee will hear from a representative of a development bank about specific matters of implementation of international water law with regard to financing transboundary water projects and will discuss matters of interpretation and implementation relevant to the Committee's work. Possible future collaboration to facilitate and support implementation of and compliance with the Convention for transboundary water projects being financed by development banks will be discussed.

# 5. Relevant outcomes of the ninth session of the Meeting of the Parties and potential contribution of the Committee to different activities under the Convention

- 9. The secretariat will report on the outcomes of the ninth session of the Meeting of the Parties to the Convention and present the programme of work for 2022–2024.
- 10. The Committee will discuss its possible contribution to the implementation of the decisions taken by the Meeting of the Parties at its ninth session and the activities foreseen under the programme of work for 2022–2024. Among other things, the Committee will discuss its possible contribution to the thirtieth anniversary of the Convention in 2022.
- 11. At its sixth meeting (Geneva, 3 and 4 May 2016), the Committee received a mandate from the Bureau of the Meeting of the Parties to the Convention to support the secretariat in answering questions from countries outside the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (ECE) region interested in acceding to the Convention (ECE/MP.WAT/IC/2016/2, paras. 9 and 10). The Committee will be informed about recent developments linked to accession to and implementation of the Convention in countries outside the ECE region. It will discuss its potential involvement in future activities.
