IWG on EDR/DSSAD Status Report

January 2022

1. Timeline in FDAV (DSSAD)

- Inventory of best ADS storage practices November 2022
- DSSAD performance elements for ADS June 2024

2. Meetings since GRVA-11 (27 Sept – 01 Oct. 2021)

- 5th October: Joint EDR SG 16 and EDR/DSSAD IWG 15
- 19th October: DSSAD SG 6

- 14th December: EDR/DSSAD IWG 16

3. Activities on DSSAD

- DSSAD performance elements for ADS

IWG started discussion on data elements of DSSAD by confirming the goal and difference between EDR and DSSAD, and IWG reconfirmed with the purpose of the DSSAD as currently specified in [the WP29 comparison document](#) (research, monitoring, liability, and legal responsibility).

- Inventory of best ADS storage practices

CPs are requested to update [EDR-DSSAD-04-04](#), DSSAD activity and way forward.

4. Next steps on DSSAD activity

- China already having DSSAD regulation will share the information with the group,
- Regarding monitoring function of DSSAD, the IWG will consider collaboration with VMAD/SG3, and
- The IWG will update the consolidated review of CPs DSSAD activities & way forward, for providing inventory of best ADS storage practices to May session of GRVA.

Ref. Activities on EDR

- The IWG proposed slight amendments and corrections to the current Regulation on EDR, and these have already been agreed in GRSG and submitted to WP.29 in March,
- The IWG is currently working on EDR for ADS, and discussed EDR for ALKS in particular but moved that discussion to ALKS SIG; the IWG will in parallel continue discussion on EDR for ADS in general,
- The IWG kicked off with EDR for HDV, and
- The IWG will later start with EDR step 2 on advanced requirements for EDR.
