Numbers

- ▶ Since2017
 - → 1 permit
 - → 2 procedures
 - \rightarrow 3 authorities
 - → Digital



▶ 1 permit

- → Urban planning acts/building projects
- → Exploitations
- → Vegetations changes
- → Retail activities

▶ 2 procedures


- → General: with public information and participation
- → Simplified: with public information



- ▶ Applicablelaw (in a nutshell)
 - → Procedural provisions (procedure, how, what, who, how long..)
 - → Environmental provisions (conditions, grounds for assessment,..)
- ▶ Procedure (in a nutshell)
 - → Submit forms
 - → Completeness check/ screening
 - → Public participation
 - → Consultation of advisory bodies
 - → Review
 - → Decision

Public participation

- ▶ Information and consultation
- ▶ Every natural person
- ▶ Permit file can be consulted
- ▶ Transboundary consultation
- Different ways to participate, depends on the project itself
 - → Information by notification before demand i.c.o. EIA or safety report
 - → Information meeting i.c.o. EIA or safety report
 - → Public inquiry



More specifically...

- ▶ Projects dangerous substances/ hazardous activities
 - → according to criteria of the Helsinki convention and European SEVESO-directive
 - → Upper-tier establishments
 - \rightarrow 15 km from border
- ▶ 1. notification
 - → Notify intention to make safety report
- ▶ 2. participation
 - → Public inquiry on safety report and project
- ▶ 3. publication
 - → Decision



1. Information on the demand-to-be

- ▶ Notification of intention + decision on content of safety report
- Digital public platform
 - → Every Belgian citizen with e-ID
- ▶ Website Departement Omgeving
 - → Platform where EIA and safety reports are coordinated
 - → Every natural person
- **▶** Email
 - → Other authorities with question if want to participate
- On paper possible on request
 - → Every natural person



2. Participation in the procedure

- ▶ Public inquiry on safety report and project demand
- ▶ Belgian citizen
 - → Public platform
- ▶ Other member states
 - → Written
 - → Give advise
- ▶ Citizen from other countries
 - → Written
 - → Currently developing digital solution



3. Information on the decision

- ▶ Resultof the assessment of safety report + decision on permit
- Digital public platform
 - → Every Belgian citizen with e-ID
 - → Display
 - → Letter in case of EIA
- ▶ Website Departement Omgeving
 - → Platform where EIA and safety reports are coordinated
 - → Every natural person
- ▶ Email
 - → Other authorities



Decision

- ▶ Procedural provisions provide in an obligation:
 - → to mention results of public participation in de review of the demand and in the decision
 - → To respond to queries about the demand, and even remedies if necessary
 - → To publish decision and announce to other country even when after review there is no transboundary effect possible



In a few numbers...

- ▶ 116 highevel SEVESO companies within range 15 km from border
- ▶ 6/116 have potential transboundary effects in case of accident
- ▶ Every 5 years update of safety report for all 116 high-level SEVESO companies
- In 2021
 - → 11 demands for permit with potential transboundary effects
 - → 0/11 had actual transboundary effect after analysis



Planning

- ▶ Integration of safety concerns in land-use planning
 - → Transboundary consultation in land-use planning is explicitly introduced into the land-use planning legislation of 2016
 - → Procedure is similar as for permit
