The text reproduced below was prepared by the experts from Liquid Gas Europe. It is based on informal document GRSG-122-42/Rev.1 distributed at the 122nd session of the Working Party on General Safety Provisions (GRSG). The modifications to the existing text are marked in bold for new or strikethrough for deleted characters.

* In accordance with the programme of work of the Inland Transport Committee for 2022 as outlined in proposed programme budget for 2022 (A/76/6 (part V, sect. 20) para. 20.76), the World Forum will develop, harmonize and update UN Regulations in order to enhance the performance of vehicles. The present document is submitted in conformity with that mandate.



I. Proposal

Paragraph 6.3.6., amend to read:

"6.3.6. ...
(b) A pressure relief valve provided that it complies to paragraph 6.4~~5~~17.8.3. below, or
..."

Paragraph 6.17.10.8., renumber as paragraph 6.17.10.9

Annex 3 to Annex 13, change references to paragraph 6.15. (and subparagraphs) to paragraph 6.17. (and subparagraphs) (50 occurrences)

Annex 16, paragraphs 18.3.1. and 18.3.2., amend to read:

"18.3.1. Perform for both samples the flow test according to paragraph 6.4~~5~~17.8.3. of this Regulation.
18.3.2. Requirements:
Both aged and non-aged samples "a" and "b" shall comply with the flow requirements as per paragraph 6.4~~5~~17.8.3. of this UN Regulation.
The non-metallic material of the samples "a" and "b" shall show no cracks, deformation or any visual damage."

II. Justification

The proposed amendment to UN Regulation No. 67 aims to correct the references to previous paragraph 6.15., renumbered as paragraph 6.17. by Supplement 15 to 01 series of Amendments to UN Regulation 67 (document ECE/TRANS/WP.29/2018/18).
