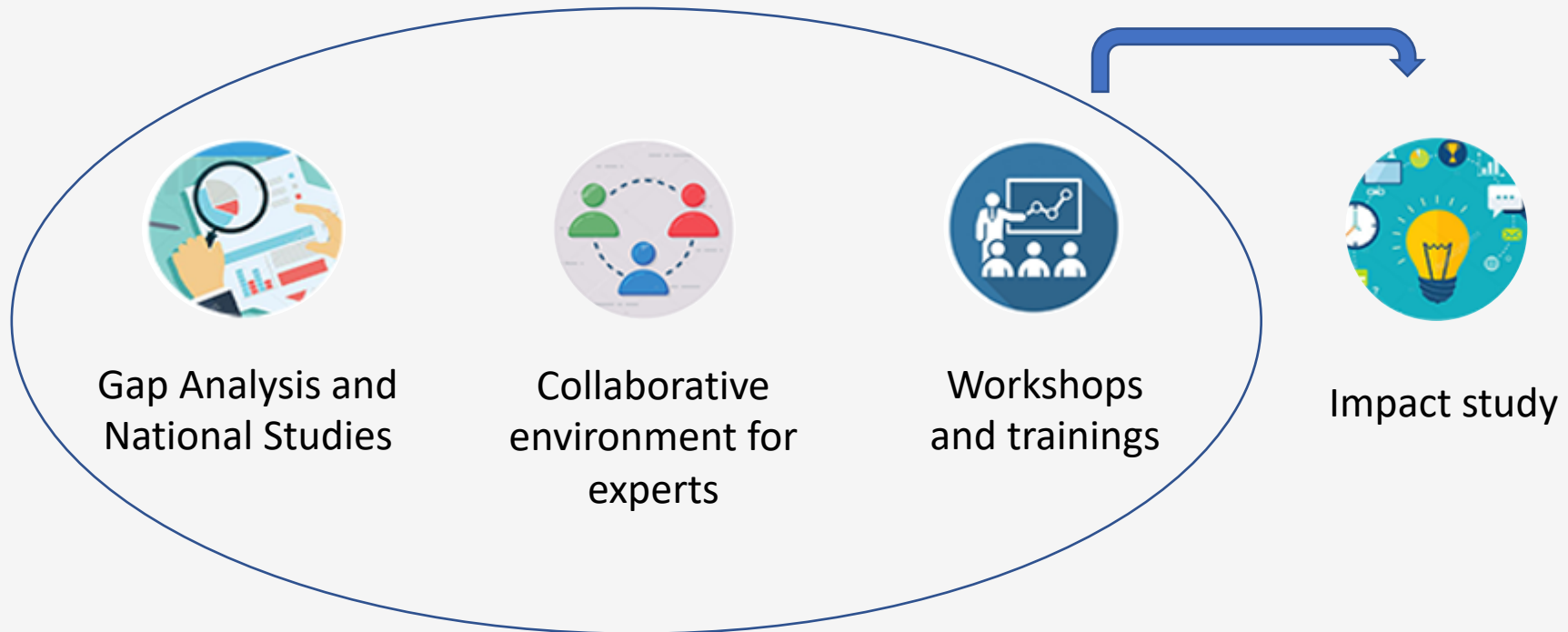

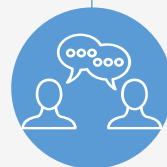

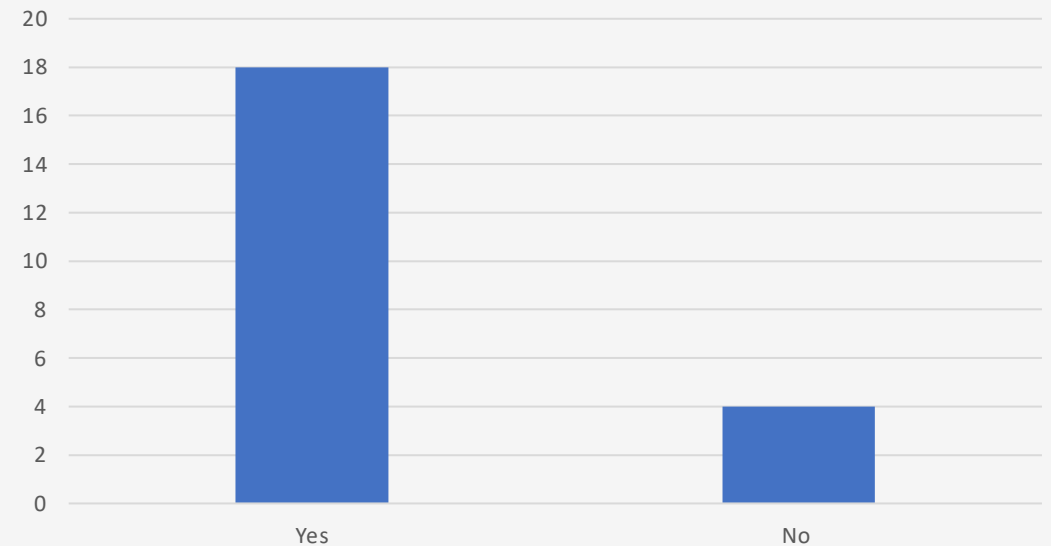
## Survey insights



UNECE

- **More than 80%** answered that, following the project, their country used or implemented the recommendations and best practices from the regional and national studies
- **Less than 20%** believe that this is not the case

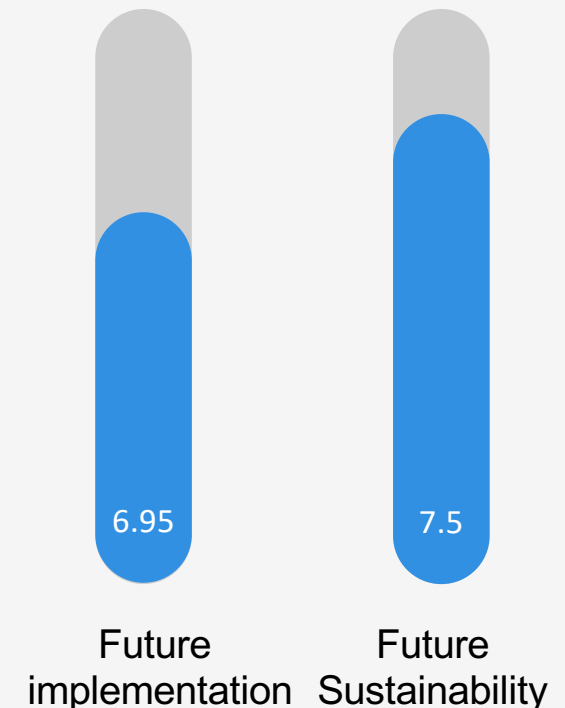

- The average likelihood of future implementation of recommendations and best practices  
→ respondents seem moderately confident about future implementation
- The average likelihood that the implemented recommendations and best practices will sustain in the future  
→ respondents are confident that the implemented recommendations or best practices will be sustain in the future

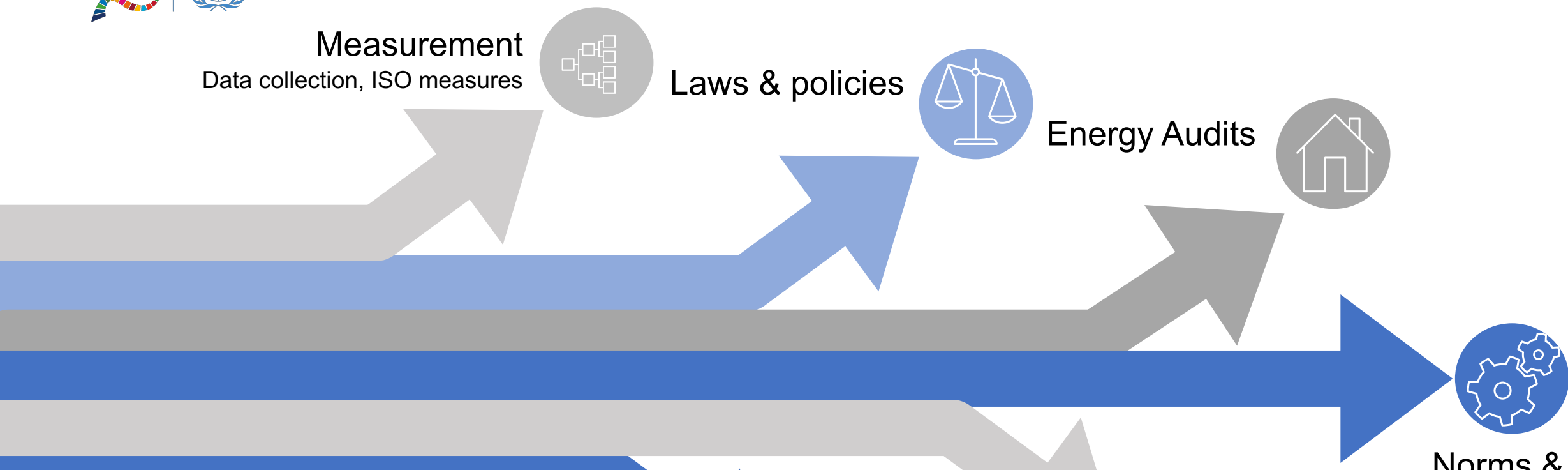

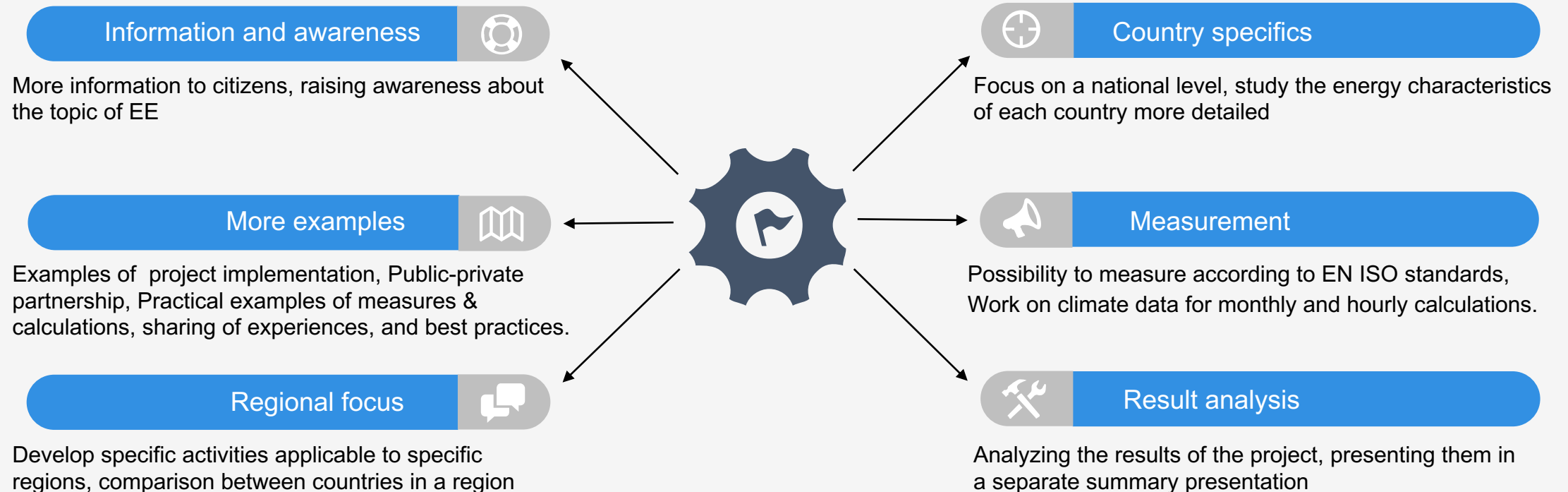

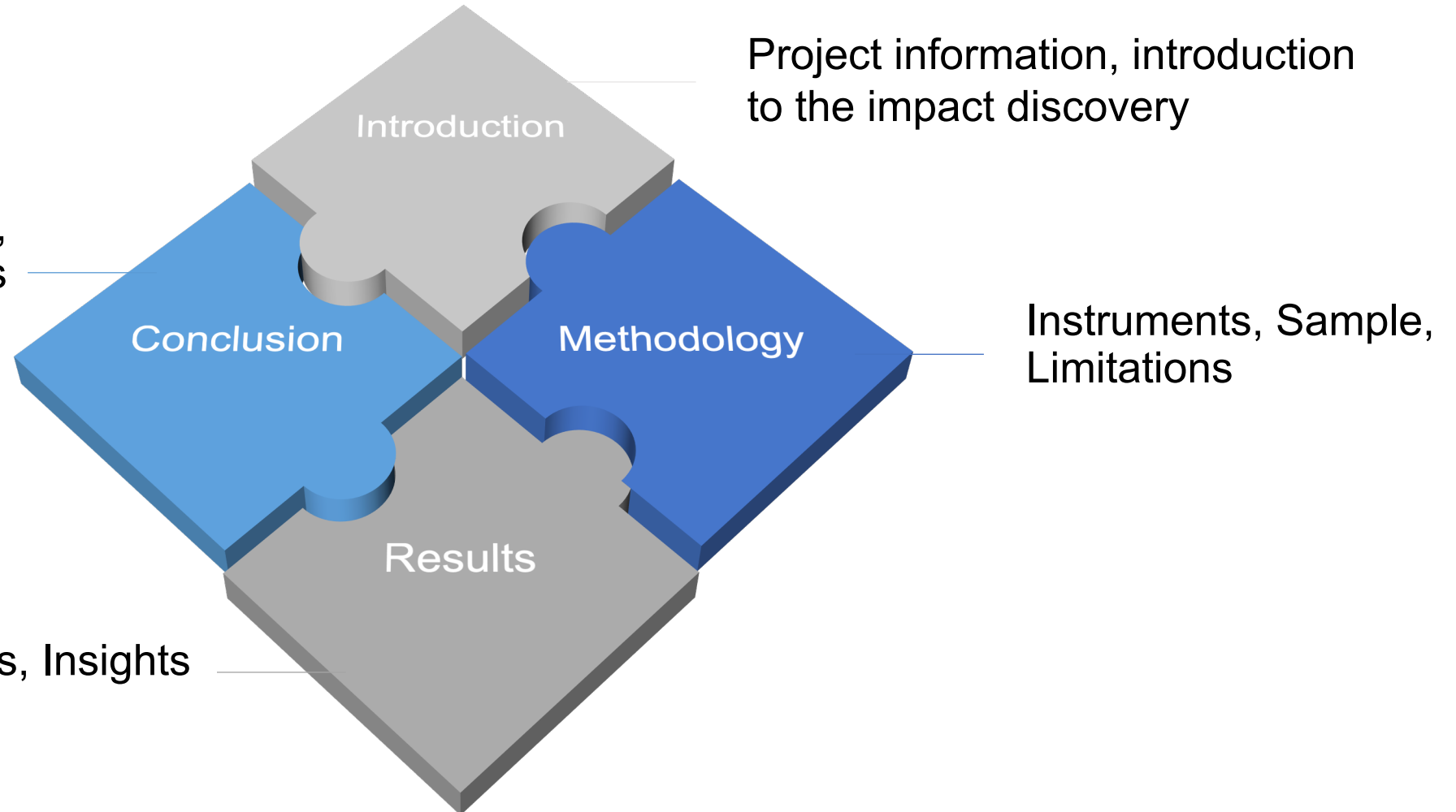
