### Decisions relating to latest developments in the region of the Economic Commission for Europe

#### Submitted by Ukraine

##### *Draft Decision*

1. Noting the extraordinary situation in the region of the Economic Commission for Europe, and recalling United Nations General Assembly resolution ES-11/1 “Aggression against Ukraine”, the Executive Committee requests the secretariat to screen ongoing extrabudgetary projects and activities and to release, within seven days following the adoption of this decision, all information to member States that could be relevant for an assessment on whether the donors, beneficiaries or participating entities are involved in actions undermining or threatening the territorial integrity, sovereignty and independence of Ukraine.
2. The Executive Committee further requests the secretariat not to enter into any new arrangement, including the signing of any new envisaged contracts or other legal obligation until member States have had the opportunity to review the above information and have approved proceeding with these obligations at its next session.
3. The Executive Committee requests all committees and subsidiary bodies to take into account the ongoing Russian Federation’s aggression and gross violation of international law when deciding on nominations to the leadership positions, including chairmanship and seats on bureau and steering committees, and invitations to events of the Economic Commission for Europe.
