- 1. Recalling the role of the Executive Committee "[dealing] with all matters related to programme planning, administrative and budget issues...", the Executive Committee requests the United Nations Centre for Trade Facilitation and Electronic Business (UN/CEFACT) to:
- (a) Send simultaneously communications on intersessional processes between UN/CEFACT and the Head of Delegation to the same member state's permanent mission in Geneva, and
- (b) Contact permanent missions in Geneva with a Head of Delegation every two years to renew the Head of Delegation's nomination for that position.
