1.0. INTRODUCTION

"The UNECE Convention on Industrial Accidents is an effective legal instrument designed to protect people and the environment from industrial accidents, especially those with transboundary effects". (1)

1.1. Objectives of the National Industrial Safety Program

The general objective of the National Industrial Safety Program is to define coordination mechanisms and guidelines for improving the environmental management process, strengthening disaster resilience and improving industrial safety.

The specific objectives of the Program are:

-providing conditions for strengthening industrial safety by improving cross-sectoral cooperation as well as cooperation of competent bodies and organizations at the vertical and horizontal level, including cooperation with industry representatives (operators) and the public,

- development of a functional major/industrial Accident Risk Management System and
- strengthening international cooperation in the field of industrial safety and possible cross-border impacts.

Measures to establish a functional system define:

- 1. Elements of control and executive part
- 2. Roles of competent bodies, organizations and institutions.
- 3. Necessary scope and manner of intersectoral cooperation and consultative processes.
- 4. Harmonization and improvement of legal frameworks.

4.1. Establishment of a system for monitoring and evaluating the degree of implementation of the Program

Establishing a system requires:

- -strengthening the capacity of the Focal Point, other competent bodies, relevant institutions and organizations,
- -regular cooperation and communication with the Secretariat of the Convention, including the necessary assistance,
- -establishing communication with the signatory members of the Convention, especially with neighboring countries and
- -exchange and distribution of information with the social community (non-governmental organizations and interested parties).

5.0. SOURCES OF FINANCING AND ASSISTANCE

- -the international community, especially through cooperation with specialized organizations and institutions,
- -budgetary funds (according to tasks and activities) of the Republic of Serbia, autonomous provinces and local selfgovernment units and
- -business organizations, associations and other legal entities.

ACTION PLAN (It will be made as a separate document)

- -The plan will result from the measures that will be defined in point 3.0.
- -The plan will include name of the activity, content of the activity, time required for the implementation of the activity, competent authority / institution or operator, indicators of the implementation of the activity and possibly estimated costs of implementation.
