I write to let you know that, out of fairness to both the Party concerned and the communicant, in the light of the present military offensive against Ukraine, the Committee proposes to postpone the session on preliminary admissibility of communication PRE/ACCC/C/2022/191 until its 75<sup>th</sup> meeting on 14-17 June 2022, unless both the Party concerned and the communicant consider themselves in a position to be able to proceed with the session as planned on Tuesday, 15 March, at the Committee's 74<sup>th</sup> meeting.

I would thus be grateful if you could let me know **before next Wednesday, 9 March**, whether you consider that you are in a position to proceed with the open session on preliminary admissibility on Tuesday, 15 March as originally planned.
