#### III. Election of the Chair and Vice-Chairs

 The Working Group elected Ms. Maia Javakhishvili (Georgia) as its Chair and Ms. Katerina Nikolovska (North Macedonia) and Mr. Johannes Mayer (Austria) as its Vice-chairs for a period of up to two years.

#### IV. Adoption of the report of the twenty-second session

 The Working Group adopted the report of its 22<sup>nd</sup> session (ECE/CEP/AC.10/2020/2) and noted the information provided by the secretariat on the status of implementation of the decisions and recommendations from its 22<sup>nd</sup> session





#### V. Implementing the mandate and terms of reference

- a) Adopted the timetable of activities for 2022 (ECE/CEP/AC.10/2021/3)
- b) Took note of the financial resources available for the implementation of activities under the Environmental Monitoring and Assessment Programme
- c) Expressed appreciation to those countries supporting financially the pan-European environmental assessment Austria, Germany, the Netherlands, Norway, Serbia and Switzerland and to the Russian Federation for its support of the current meeting
- d) Requested its members and the secretariat to continue their fundraising efforts to enable the full implementation of activities planned for 2021–2022, including the preparation of the pan-European environmental assessment and the holding of the next sessions of the Joint Task Force on Environmental Statistics and Indicators and the Working Group continuously





### VI. Reporting on the Shared Environmental Information System to support a regular process of environmental assessment

- a) Adopted the final review report on the establishment of the Shared Environmental Information System in Europe and Central Asia (ECE/CEP/AC.10/2021/6)
- b) Suggested the continued use of the Shared Environmental Information System reporting tool and assessment framework for upcoming reviews for selected indicators and in support of pan-European environmental assessments – see agenda item 4
- c) Requested the secretariat to inform the Committee on Environmental Policy of the outcomes of the agenda item done





#### VII. Regular pan-European environmental assessment supported by the Shared Environmental Information System

- a) Welcomed the draft elements of the next pan-European environmental assessment (ECE/CEP/AC.10/2021/5)
- b) Took note of the progress made, timeline and next steps for the assessment
- c) Welcomed the presentations of thematic sections of the assessment by the authors
- d) Requested the authors of the thematic sections of the assessment to take into account the comments made by members of the Working Group and to focus on policy-relevant conclusions done
- Encouraged member States to support preparation of the assessment with further financial contributions – largely achieved





### VII. Regular pan-European environmental assessment supported by the Shared Environmental Information System – continued

- f) Requested the secretariat to inform the Committee on Environmental Policy and its Bureau of the outcomes of the agenda item done
- g) Also requested the secretariat to engage the Joint Task Force on Environmental Statistics and Indicators in the review of progress and clearance of draft elements of the assessment – done
- h) Further requested the secretariat to provide an update on the assessment at its next session, for final clearance see agenda item 5





### VIII. Sharing and integration of economic, social and environmental data with regard to the implementation of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development

- a) Took note of the information provided on upcoming regional events and initiatives promoted in 2021 by international and regional organizations related to activities of the Working Group
- b) Invited representatives of regional and international organizations to provide regular updates to the Working Group on upcoming events and initiatives of relevance see agenda item 6
- c) Took note of the suggestions related to how the work on environmental information, data and indicators could better support the development of the pan-European environmental assessment(s) and other activities related to the Working Group
- d) Took note of the suggestions on topics for the 24th session of the Working Group
